Tuesday June 27 First part of this day began with squally and rough sea, with strong S.W. Wind latter part, with strong N.W. Wind and clear weather, Vessel under two try sails and jib, standing to the Windward on Starboard tack, three Whalers in sight, we Broke out Bread Pump attended to

Wednesday June 28 First part of this day came in with fresh breeze from the S.W. and clear weather, Schooner under main try sail fore sails and head sails being up to the Windward, Saw a Whaling Bark, "Bertha" going off East. at sun down we took in fore sails and flying jib, set fore try sails, pump attended to every two hours.

Thursday June 29 First and latter part of this day came in with light S.W. Wind and calm, Vessel under all sails set being up to the Windward, saw a Porpoise and Gramps, pump attended to

Saturday July 1 First part of this day came in with light S.W. Wind, and clear weather, latter part with calm, and very light breeze from the S.E. Vessel under all sails set. Steering N.W. =

Sunday July 2 First part of this day came in with fine S.W. breeze, and clear weather Vessel under all sails set steering N.W. West latter part, with strong breeze and squall we took in main sail and foresail, we set for main try sails, saw a Merchant Bark going S.E. pump attended to

Monday July 3 First part of this day began with light breeze and calm, latter part with light Wind from the N.E. and foggy weather Vessel under all sails set steering N.W. West. Saw a Gramps and Porpoise, at sun set shorting sails, pump attended to
Lat 38.48 Long 71.00

Tuesday July 4 First part of this day came in with very light breeze from the N.E. and clear weather, Vessel under all sails set steering N.W. West. at sun set shorting sails - pump attended to
Lat 38.00 Long 71.49

Wednesday July 5 First part of this day began with light S.E. Wind and calm, with clear weather, at 9 o'clock A.M. saw Whaling Schooner with two Boats down, chasing Whales. We lowered two Boats, we catch the Whales on each Boat, we took the Whales alongside at 4 P.M. hoist Boats up, and put gear up, we commenced cutting at 5 P.M. and hauled out one at 7 P.M. and we have one to cut next morning, we clear up the head and took in main sail, set main try sails and we set Watch, pump attended to
