Thursday July 6 First part of this day came in with very light breeze and clear, in morning we set main sails, and commence to chit in Whale, at 9 A.M. we finished out in - and gave took gears down, and clear up the head, at 4 P.M. we start fire, at sun set we took in main sails and Flying jib. Set main try sail, pump attended to.

Friday July 7 First part of this day began with light West wind and clear weather, vessel under main sail and head sail, Boiling, this day we pump out some fresh water, and stow some oil down, saw a Merchant Bark going West, at sun set we took in main sail and Flying jib, set main try sails, pump attended to.

Lat 34.48 Long 73.12.40

Saturday July 8 First part of this day began with fine breeze from the West and foggy weather, we finished Boiling, vessel under all sails set cruising. this day we put all the oil down, and stow off the hole, and wash the vessel in side, saw Steamer going to West at sun set we shorting sails and lay on Port tack, pump attended to.

Lat 34.50 Long 73.20

Sunday July 9 First of this day came in with light West wind, and clear weather, vessel under all sails set on Port tack, cruising, at 10 o'clock A.M. we raised school of small Whales, we lower two Boats, each 1, we took these Whales along side at 3 P.M. hoist Boats up, and put gears up at 4 P.M. we commence out in lat. 7. P.M. we finished, took gears down, and clear up the head, we shorting sails, Lat 34.52 Long 71.02

Monday July 10 First part of this day began with fine West breeze and clear weather, in morning we set main sails and Flying jib, standing on Port tack to the Windward. Boiling, saw a Merchant Bark going West, saw a Porpoise, at sun set took in main sail and Flying jib, set main try sail - pump attended to.

Lat 38.00 Long 71.12

Tuesday July 11 First part of this day came in with very light West wind, and clear weather, vessel under main sail and head sails, on Port tack Boiling, at 10 A.M. we finished Boiling, Capt. Emma, Sick, this day we put some oil down, and put some fresh water on deck, pump attended to in observation.

Wednesday July 12 First part of this day began with very light breeze from the West, latter part calm, vessel under main try sail fore sail and head sail, standing to a Windward on Starboard tack, then we finished stow down the oil, and wash the vessel in side, all ready for next day, saw a three mast Schooner going to Westward, at sun set took in fore sail and Flying jib, set fore try sails, pump attended to.

Lat 37.30 Long 71.13

Thursday July 13 First part of this day began with very light breeze from the West and clear, vessel under all sails set cruising, saw lots of Porpoises, crew making O.K., at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to.

Lat 37.12 Long 71.20
