

Monday July 24 First part of this day began with light SEast wind and show Weather. Vessel under all sails set standing to the Eastward. We came to "E. P. Cownell" at sun set shorting sails, lay on Port tack pump attended to.

Tuesday July 25 First part of this day began with light NWest Wind and clear Weather. Vessel under all sail set standing to the West on Starboard tack, in company with "E. P. Cownell" at 5 P.M. She outlight, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to.

Lat 37.04 Long 73.24

Wednesday July 26 First part of this day began with light breezy and calm all day. Vessel under all sails set, steering West, at 4 P.M. we sighted a Whaling Schooner, to the leeward with us, at sun set shorting sails, lay on Starboard tack, Scompopanias and Gumpet pump attended to.

Thursday July 27 First part of this day began with light SEast breeze and clear Weather. Vessel under all sails set standing to the South. We came to "Golden City" at sun set shorting sails lay on Starboard tack pump attended to.

Friday July 28 First part of this day began with strong SEast Wind and rough sea. Vessel under fore sail main sail and head sail, in company with "Golden City" at 10 A.M. moderate wind we set main sail standing to the South, at noon we raised school of small Whales, we lower two

Boats and "Golden City" lower two Boats made with us we get one Whale and "Golden City" get one we took three Whale along side at 6 P.M. and get gear up, we commence cut in at 7 P.M. we finish at 8 P.M. we took in main sail and lay on Port tack, pump attended to.

Lat 36.28 Long 73.54

Saturday July 29 First part of this day began with light NWest wind and clear Weather. in morning we set main sail and flying jib on Starboard tack, at 6 A.M. we raised a large Whale, we lower two Boats in company with "Golden City" the Whale going to quick to the leeward at 9 A.M. Whale was outlight, the Boats come on Board hoist up, and we stand in to the NWest - Boiling, E. Swift in sight in afternoon began to rain and squall we took in main sail, and flying jib we set fore, main try sail pump attended to.

Lat 36.31 Long 73.48

Sunday July 30 First part of this day began with strong Southerly Wind and Squall with rain. Vessel under two try sails and fore try sails standing to the Windward, at 6 A.M. we finished Boiling, and put oil down - stow the holl, and wash the Vessel in side "Golden City" in sight pump attended every two hours.

Lat 36.50 Long 73.29 W.

Monday July 31 First part of this day began with fresh North West Wind and foggy Weather. Vessel under fore sail try sail and jib, standing to the South at 9 A.M. moderate wind we set main sail. We came to "Golden City" and square up the oel at 6 o'clock P.M. we raised a school of small Whales going to Windward. quick we did not lower the Boats.
