Tuesday

August 1 First part of this day began with fresh breeze from the West, in foggy weather, vessel under fore sail, main try sail and head sail, at 6. AM the "Golden City" raised a school of small Whales, she got one, we did not lower the Boats, the Whales going to quick to leeward, at noon, blowing strong we took in fore sail and flying jib standing on Starboard tack. The Wind hauled up to West with squally "Golden City" went out sight, pump attended to
Leatt 36.45 Long 73.26

Wednesday

August 2 First part of this day began with very light breeze and calm all day vessel under all sails set cruising, at sun set shorting sails, pump attended to
Leatt 36.35 Long 73.39 W

Thursday

Aug 3 First part of this day began with light West wind and clear weather vessel under all sail set cruising, saw a large Boat towing a large Steamer bound to Northwest, at 4. PM we raised a school of small Whales we lower two Boats - S.B. catch one, and the other went to the Windward, quick, can not get near, we take these Whales along side at 7.30 we hoist the Boats up, and shorting sails,
Leatt 36.54 Long 73.24

Friday

August 4 First part of this day began with light Easterly Wind and clear weather in morning we set main sails and commence to cut in Whales at 7. AM we finish cut in took gears down, and clear up the head were ship to Southward, at 9. AM we start fire, at sun set took in main sail and flying jib, lay on Starboard tack, pump attended to
Leatt 36.45 Long 73.42

Saturday

August 5 First part of this day began good West breeze and clear weather at first part of night we finished Spiling at 6.30 in morning we raised a school of small Whales going to West. we lower two Boats, we shorting all fore noon at 1. PM S.B. struck 1 Long Ball, we took these Whales along side at 2.30 PM. and we put some oil down and get gears up at 5. PM we finish cut in and we clear up the head, and took gears down shorting sails, pump attended to
Leatt 36.49 Long 74.02

Sunday

August 6 First part of this day began with fresh West Wind and clear weather vessel under try sail and jib, backing on Starboard tack, at 7.30 in morning we raised a three Bull Whale going to the Windward, we lower two Boats, and we caught two S.B. and S.B. we take these Whales along side at 2. PM. we put gears up and commence cut in at 4. and we put some oil down, at 6. PM we finish cut in one Whale, and lower the other to cut in next morning, pump attended to, at 7. we took in main sail set main try sail,
Leatt 36.40 Long 74.17

Monday

August 7 First part of this day began with fresh West Wind, in morning we set main sail, and commence to cut in Whales, at 9. AM we finish cut in, and we took gears down and clear up the head in after noon, light breeze and smooth sea we set jib standing to the South on Starboard tack, takes pump out some fresh Water and put some oil down, at sun set took in main sail set main try sail pump attended to
Leatt 37.44 Long 73.54
