

Tuesday June 19 First part of these day, fresh breeze from the South East, with heavy rain, latter part, blowing hard with heavy sea running. Vessel under two try sails and fore topsail - laying to, three more Whaling Schooner, in sight, pump carefully attended, no observation sun obscure -

Wednesday June 20 First part of these day, more moderate breezes, and foggy weather in morning we set get shunting to the East on Port tack, the "Bertha Hecker" in sight in morning. These day we made new fit for deadwood Boat, saw a lot of Whales, at 6: PM were round on Starboard tack, pump attended to Lat 38° 14' Long 71° 42'

Thursday June 21 First part of these day came in with very light breeze from the South East, and clear weather, vessel under all sails set shunting to the Windward on Starboard tack, at 3: PM. We saw ship on Port tack, heading S. West, at 4 o'clock PM. We raised a large whale going to the Windward, we kept beating up after them, but we can't get near at sun, set we shorting sails, pump attended to Lat 38° 30' Long 72° 05' W.

Friday June 22 First part of these day came in with light breeze from the South West, and clear weather, vessel under all sails on Starboard tack standing to the South we hove out Beam and Sea, at sun down we shorting sails, pump attended to. Lat 38° 30' Long 72° 04' W.

Saturday June 23 First part of these day came in with light South West breeze, and very clear weather, vessel under all sails set on Starboard tack evening saw a merchant-Bark going to the East, at sun set we shorting sails and were round on Port tack. saw lots of Whales, pump attended to Lat 38° 28' Long 71° 42' W.

Sunday June 24 First part of these day began with light breeze from the South East with squally and rain in fore noon, latter part, wind shifted to the Northwest and weather clear up we set main sail and fore sail on Starboard tack, steering S. West, saw a Steamer going to the East - saw a lot of Whales, at sun set we shorting sails, pump attended to Lat 38° 40' Long 71° 39' W.

Monday June 25 First part of these day began with very light breeze from the North East, and clear weather, vessel under all sails set, latter part calm, saw a three-mast schooner going to South, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to Lat 38° 20' Long 71° 50'

Tuesday June 26 First part of these day, calm, and latter part very light breeze from the North East we set all the sails steering South on Port tack crew employed repairing the main gas-top, at sun set we shorting sails pump attended to Lat 38° 35' Long 72° 00' W.

Wednesday June 27 First part of these day very light breeze from the South East, vessel under short sails, standing to the South, latter part, wind shifted to the North East, we run off South - saw a lot of Whales, at sun set shorting sails, pump attended to Lat 38° 27' Long 71° 42'
