Remarks on board Sunday Nov 15th 1863
First part of this 24 hours strong wind
From the W^W Cours S & E took in top galent
Sails at 4 P M. had heavy squalls with rain
at 7 P M double reefed the top sails furl'd
the main sail at 6 P M started the works
later part pleasant weather all sail set
I'm ploid in putting on latings on the sails
So ends this day Lat 39.10 N Long 34.20 W

Remarks on board Monday Nov 16th 1863
First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze
From the W^W W^W all sail out Cours
S & E. Implord in boiling at 8 P M

Had heavy squalls. took in top galent sails
Double reef'd the top sails later part
Breeze from the W^W during main top galent sail
So ends this 24 hours Lat 39.36 N Long

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 17th 1863
First part of this day strong winds from N^W W^W
Cours S & E at 8 P M finest boiling later part
Wind more modart all sail set saw a sail
heading to the W so ends this day
Lat 34.59 N Long 30.46 W

Remarks on board Wednesday 18th 1863
First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from
N^W W^W Cours S all sail set middle part
Squally took in top galent sails later part
rain squally weather so ends this day
Lat 32.18 N Long 28.40 W

Remarks on board Thursday 19th 1863
All this 24 hours fine weather all sail set
I'm ploid in lashing spars and putting on
Shithing on the rails so ends this day
Set top mast Stud on sail

Remarks on board Friday 20th Nov 1863

All this 24 hours present weather light wind
From the W^W Cours S by W implord in ships duty
So ends this 24 hours Lat 28.06 N Long 28.00 W

Remarks on board Saturday Nov 21th 1863
All this 24 hours present weather light winds from
W^W Cours S & W^W latter part wind from the N^W
Implord in ships duty so ends this 24 hours:
Lat 25.33 N Long 27.00 W

Remarks on board Sunday Nov 22th 1863
First part of this 24 hours light wind from the
N^W Cours S & W^W middle and later part present
Weather light wind from the N^W E Cours S by W^W
So ends this day Lat 23.38 N Long 26.46 W

Remarks on board Monday Nov 23th 1863
First part of this day light wind from the
N^W E Cours S by W^W middle and later part
Wind from E I'm ploid in ships duty
So ends this 24 hours 21.37 N Long 26.32 W

Remarks on board Tuesday Nov 24th 1863
First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the
E^W E Cours S by W^W middle and later part
Strong winds fine weather implord in ships duty
So ends this 24 hours Lat 18.35 N Long 26.20 W

Remarks on board Wednesday Nov 25th 1863
First part of this day strong winds from the
E^W E Cours S by W^W at 9 P M raised land
4 points on the Sahard how St Anthony one of
The Cape Verde Islands Seward S with fresh
breeze from the N^W E all sail set, passed
this in the night implord in ships duty
At 7 P M St Anthony in site having N^W E
Distent 35 mib so ends this day
Lat 15.35 Long
