Remarks on Board Thursday Nov 26th 1863

First part of this day strong winds from the NE
Cours S by E brags in site got under the
Sea of it had it Cabin at 8 PM got light
Aire from NE later part fresh breeze
So ends this day Lat 14 28 N Long

Remarks on Board Friday Nov 27th 1863

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the NE Cours
S by E impleid in ships duty took the potatoes out
picked them over so ends this 24 hours
Lat 12.09 N Long 23.30

Remarks on Board Saturday Nov 28th 1863

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from
NE Cours S by E at day light saw a
Steam Ship a steam steering SSE at 11 o'clock
PM raised a sail to the windward steering to the
N Impleid in fitting fore and misen Royal
yards about the royals sent them aloft
Sent out main top galent Studdensail
So ends this day Lat 9.22 N Long

Remarks on Board Sunday Nov 29th 1863

First part of this 24 hours strong winds from
The NE Cours S by E at 6 PM had rain
Squalls and merble winds and Cabin later part

Light wind from the W and clear all sail
So ends this 24 hours Lat 8.35 N Long 21.30 W

Remarks on Board Monday Nov 30th 1863

First part of this 24 hours light wind from
The W NE Cours S all sail set to ~~set~~
This day later part had rain squalls
Aire Cabin so ends this day
Lat Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 1st 1863

First part of this 24 hours got the wind from the
NNE all sail set at 1 PM strong winds and
Cloudy at 8 PM wind light Cours S Middle
And later part rain squalls merble winds and Cabin
So ends this day Lat No obs Long No obs

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 2nd 1863

First part of this day light are with rain squalls
merble wind Cabin at 10 o'clock had wind from
SSE heading SE at 8 PM tacked ship heading
W by S so ends this day
Lat 5.42 N Long 22.57 W

Remarks on Board Thursday December 3rd 1863

All this day fine weather. Strong winds from the
SSE ~~Cours~~ heading S W at sail set
Impleid in ships duty saw several sails com of them
Steering to the N others to the SW so ends this day
Lat 4 12 N Long 22 19 W

Remarks on Board Friday December 4th 1863

All this 24 hours strong winds from the SSE W
heading S W all sail set saw several sails
Steering to the N Impleid in ships duty
Cut out 5 boats Sails 5 jibs so ends this day
Lat 1 39 N Long 24.20 W

Remarks on Board Saturday December 5th

All this 24 hours fine breeze from the
SE heading S W all sail set
Impleid in ships duty so ends this day
Lat 00.08 S Long 25.05 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 6th 1863

All this 24 hours strong winds from
SSE heading S W by S took in roils
So ends this day Lat 2.24 S Long 26.20 W
