Remarks on Board Friday December 18th 1863

First part of this day light winds from the
W^NW^{ly} Cours S^W had rain at 10th AM
Spoke bark Sarah Whittapisset 7 months out
240 lbs Handy Master gained with her calm
7 Sails in site kep 2 men on deck all day
For fitting
Wind from S so ends this day
Latd 26.78 S Long

Remarks on Board Saturday December 19th 1863
First part of this 24 hours light air from the
SSE Cours S^W & W middle part fresh
Breeze from E all sail set employd in setting
up rigging 4 sails in site so ends this day
Latd 28.37 S Long 73.30 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 20th 1863
First part of this day fresh breeze from the
E Cours S^W & S latter part Wind from
N^W several sails in site so ends this day
Latd 30.41 S Long 75.14 W

Remarks on Board Monday December 21st 1863
First part of this 24 hours Calm middle part
Light wind from the N^W Cours S^W
At 6 AM took a squall from the S com down
So double reefed top sails furl'd jib and mainsail
had rain so ends this day Latd. No obs Long 76.45

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 22nd
First part of this 24 hours a strong breeze from the
SSE under double reefed top sails at 3 PM
Set the top sails and maintop galeont sail 4 sails in
site Middle part ayale from the S^W heading
SSE Cariny double reefed top sails jib and
Mainsail furl'd latter part the same so ends this
Day Latd 32.22 S Long 75.49 W W W

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 23rd 1863

First part of this day ayale from the S^W
heading SSE cariny double reefed top sails
At 7 PM wore ship heading W
Middle part wind light all sail set latter
part Calm imployd in setting up wisen rigging
So ends this day Latd 32.34 S Long

Remarks on Board Thursday December 24th 1863
First part of this day light wind from the SSE
Cours S^W by S latter part wind from the
NE fresh breeze imployd in stowing down in
The main hatch brok out bread and Flour and
Cooperd it so ends this day Latd 33.34 S ?

Remarks on Board Friday December 25th 1863
First part of this 24 hours light wind from the
N Cours S^W by S middle and latter part fresh
Breeze from the N^W imployd in braking out
In the hole for bread and flour and cooperd
It so ends this day Latd 35.36 S Long

Remarks on Board Saturday December 26th 1863
First part of this day light wind from the
S at 4 o'clock PM tacked ship heading W^SW
At 6 PM wind haled to the SSE heading
S^W strong wind latter part wind light
Imployd in braking out Bread and Flour
Coopernd it sawn over sail so ends this day
Lat 36.55 S Long 51.56 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 27th 1863
First part of this 24 hours modart breeze from
The SE Cours S^W by S middle part
Wind from the N^W latter part wind
From the N^W fresh breeze from the N^W
All sail set so ends this day
Latd 38.23 S Long 53.28 W
