

Remarks on Board Thursday April 7th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the S E Course W S W at 6 P M had rain squalls took in top galeent sails at 8 P M large quantity of rain later part clear employed in ships duty
So ends this 24 hours Latd 22.39 N Long

Remarks on Board Friday April 8th 1864
First part of this 24 hours light wind from the S E Course W had good deal of rain later part wind from the N N E all sail set employed in ships duty so ends this day
Latd 22.55 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday April 9th 1864

All this 24 hours strong wind from the N caring all sail had rain squalls later part pleasant weather so ends this day
Latd 23.21 N Long 170.50 W

Remarks on Board Sunday April 10th
All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N Course W caring all sail saw 2 ships on to the S W heading to the W
So ends this 24 hours Latd 24.22 N Long 174.50 W

Remarks on Board Monday April 11th 1864
All this 24 hours fine weather employed in setting up the head stays and other work wind from the N Course W by N so ends this 24 hours
Latd 25.14 N Long W

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 13th 1864
All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N E Course W by N employed in ships duty caring all sail so ends this day
Latd 26.24 N Long 178.33 E

Remarks on Board Thursday April 14th 1864

This day commences with fine weather fresh breeze from the N E Course W by N later part wind from the N all sail set saw a hump back so ends this 24 hours Latd 28.11 N Long 175.51 E

Remarks on Board Friday April 15th 1864
All this 24 hours pleasant weather employed in making Bone spungyarn sent the cutting prevents a loft
So ends this 24 hours Latd 28.54 N Long 173.31 E

Remarks on Board Saturday April 16th 1864
All this 24 hours pleasant weather light wind from N E later part wind from S E Course W by N so ends this day Latd 30.55 N Long 171.17 E

Remarks on Board Sunday April 17th 1864
First part of this day light winds from the S E Course W by N all sail set later part wind from the S fresh breeze saw several fin backs so ends this day
Latd 32.46 N Long 171.36 E

Remarks on Board Monday April 18th 1864
First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S S W caring all sail at 9 P M wind holed to the N N W heading N E took in top galeent sails and double reefed the top sails had rain latter part cloudy heading N E by E caring hull topsails so ends this 24 hours Latd 34.33 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 19th 1864
First part of this day fresh breeze from the N N W heading N E all sail set at 6 P M tacked ship heading W later part strong breeze took in top galeent sails tacked ship heading N brok out the slops for the men
So ends this day Latd 35.25 N Long
