

Remarks on board Wednesday May 11th 1864

First part of this 24 hours light winds from the N^WE heading E^SE middle part fresh breeze from the N^W later part wind from the N^WE heading N^W so ends this 24 hours Lat 58.19 Long

Remarks on board Thursday May 12th 1864

This 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from the N^WE heading N^W at 4 P M latched ship heading to the E all sail out at 10 took in the fore and main top galent sails at 12 took in main galent sail at 4 A M double reefed the top sails blowing a moderate gale thick and snowey weather Staining tack and tack working to the N^E So ends this day Lat no obs Long no obs

Remarks on board Friday May 13th 1864

First part of this 24 hours agale with snow from the N^WE heading N^W at 8 P M wore ship heading E later part more moderate heading N by W At 11 A M comin to ice worked thru the center ice Packed ship heading E by S so ends this day Lat 58.59 N Long 172.09 E

Remarks on board Saturday May 14th 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N^WE heading to the E curing all sail at 4 P M Boased a sail steering in to the N^W later part Working to the E at 10 spoke ship Europa Milton of New bed ford Lin up hear 2 weeks so ends this day Lat 58.34 N Long

Remarks on board Sunday May 15th 1864

First part of this day light winds from the N^WE Middle and later part wind from the south In the ice working to the N gaining with ship Europa of New bed ford thick fogg laying aback part of the time so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday May 16th 1864

First part of this day light are from the S Stearing in to the N at 4 P M wind from the N^WE in the ice an wind breezed up have a back double reefed the top sails at mid night in heavy Ice took in fore and main top sails close reefed the Main top sail at 3 got out of the ice Europa in Company later part gaining working to the N Thur the ice cloudy weather fresh breeze from the N^WE so ends this day Lat 58.19 N

Remarks on board Tuesday May 17th 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N^WE Working in to the N^E in the ice some considerable clear Water at 8 A M got up to pack ice have a back in Company with Europa of New bedford saw a sail to the S^E of our working to the N wind light so ends this day Lat 59.17 N Long 175.50

Remarks on board Wednesday May 18th 1864

First part of this day light are and calm Laying aback in the ice could not get any further In to the N^E later part light winds from the S^W working in to the S^E Europa and bark Briganday in company so ends this 24 hours Lat 59.14 N Long

Remarks on board Thursday May 19th 1864

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S^W working to the S^E in company with Europa and Briganday Laying the ice Middle and later part strong wind from the S^E thick snowey weather gaining with the Mt Waabston of New bedford 18 months out with 7 lbs so ends this day Lat no obs

Remarks on board Friday May 20th 1864

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S^E thick weather with snow in flood in working in to N^E thur the ice saw 2 sails so ends this day Lat 59.20 N Long 175.58
