

Remarks on Board Sunday June 12th 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the
S W steering N E at 11 P M com to ice here
black till 5 A M thick foggy later part wind
N E beating to the windward 4 ships in company
Ice broke up so we could work ship in it
So ends this day Satt 61.34 Long

Remarks on Board Monday June 13th 1864
First part of this day wind from the N E thick
foggy beating to the wind and then patches of ice
at 8 A M steard of S W so ends this day
Satt 61.44 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 14th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the
N E steering to the N S W at 2 P M saw
Whowhead toward and went in to the ice
But did not see him a game sub plenty
of devil fish comin thick com on board
Caption on board Mercury run for her
But did not see her middle part
Calm later part wind from the S W
thick with strong wind at 10 A M wind
blowed strong raised the ship so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday June 15th 1864

First part of this day strong wind from the
S W thick foggy working to the west and
at 6 A M steard of N W then N E
Saw the land thick later part wind S
So ends this day

Remark on Board Thursday June 16th 1864
First part of this day fresh breeze from the S
thick foggy middle part wind light later part
Wind S E with rain working to the E N E
Saw 4 ships in site so ends this day
Satt Long

Remarks on Board Friday June 17th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the
S E working to the E then the ice thick foggy
later part wind from the S wind light laying
black in the ice thick foggy saw the Mercury
gamed with her so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday June 18th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the S S W
thick foggy middle and later part thick foggy wind
Whowhead about from all quarters laying black most of the
time Ice calved so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday June 19th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the S W
thick foggy saw nothing but thick foggy and ice
at 3 P M lit up saw howheads toward
Got one helped the Mercury get a whale
so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday June 20th 1864

First part of this day light wind and clear
but the whale later part saw whals toward
Got a nother one thick foggy 3 sails in 5
site whaling plenty of whals saw the
Land 30 miles of ice quit heavy
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 21st 1864

This day light wind thick foggy
cutting at 8 A M saw whals toward got
one cut him in saw 3 ships cutting
So ends this day
