

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 14th 1864

This day commences with strong wind from the N E had sea on middle part blowing agale caring sail working of the ice long to the leeward later part blew heavy caring Double reefed top sails thick by spels So ends this day heading E S E by compass Lat 70.40 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday September 15th 1864
First part of this day blowing agale from the N E caring double reefed fore sails and foresail At 2 P M took in fore top sail and fore courses Clove reefed the main top sail blowing hard later part more moderate wore ship at 4 P M heading N N W so double reefed tops fore top sail Clove reefed so ends this day Lat no obs

Remarks on Board Friday September 16th 1864
All this 24 hours blowing agale from the N E staning tack and tack thick by spels Spark dark Mercury 6 whals saw one whale to day so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday September 17th 1864
First part of this 24 hours blowing agale from the N E Middle part more moderate at 4 P M spoke dark Machinery of New Bedford gaming with her Saw whales loward com in thick foggy Calm. So ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Sunday September 18th 1864
First part of this 24 hours Calm at 7 P M got light breeze from the S E steering to the N N E At day light raised whals loward got at 11 A M Whale got him long side at 9 A M Sent 5 boats of agane calm saw plenty of whals could not get on to them so ends this day Lat 70.50 N

Remarks on Board Monday September 19th 1864

First part of this day light wind from the N E Middle part and later part strong wind from the N E heaving to the windward raised whals to the Windward worked up to him loward got one took him Long side cut him in so ends this day Lat 70.50 N Long 165.30 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 20th 1864
All this 24 hours fine weather saw plenty of whals got 2 whals this day cut them in bearing in site So ends this day Lat 70.50 N Long 165.30 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 21th 1864
All this 24 hours fine weather plenty of whals got 2 whals long side commenced cutting so ends this day Lat 70.40 Long

Remarks on Board Thursday Sep 22th
Employed in cutting all night got three cutting At 9 A M sent all hands lie low at 2 P M Colled all hands cleared a way 3 heads fresh breeze from the S W saw several whals did not lower for them so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Friday Sep 23th 1864
First part of this day fresh breeze from the S W Middle part light wind from the S E Saw several whals loward and chast them later part struck one got him cut him in Saw ice in to the N of us so ends this day Lat 70.45 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday Sep 24th 1864
First part of this day light are and Calm later part fresh breeze from the E N E saw whals loward got one cut him in Saw ice to the N W of us so ends this day Lat 70.40 N Long 163.30 W
