

Remarks on Board Sunday Sep 25th 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E N E with snow squalls started the works standing tack and tack so ends this day
Lat 70.40 N Long 163.06 W

Remarks on Board Monday Sep 26th 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E S E Impleid in hoiling braking out for Slops later part wind from S S E heading W thick fog by spells so ends this day
Lat 70.39 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday Sep 27th 1864

First part of this day strong wind from the N E caring double reefed top sails Impleid in Boiling later part blowing again saw ice saw plenty of Whales to riged to lower for them more ship heading E S E so ends this day
Lat 71.30 N Long 163.43 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday Sep 28th 1864

First part of this 24 hours blowing a gale from the N E heading to the E S E later part heading to the N W Impleid in hoiling And Stowing down in the after hatch stowed 100 blbs so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday Sep 29th 1864

This day commences with a gale from the N E heading E S E at 7 A M kept of S S E set the fore cours later part blowing hard kept of S S W saw the land so ends this day
Lat 70.27 N Long 164.24 W

Remarks on Board Friday Sep 30th 1864

First part of this day blowing a gale from the N E running S by W saw the land caring double reefed top sails at 7 P M. home two heading N W at 5 A M kept of S S E saw Cape Lichen Wind more moderate made all sail started the works fine weather so ends this day Lat 68.47 N Long 166.47 W

Remarks on Board Saturday Sep October 1st 1864

Still this 24 hours calm land in site the E shore Impleid in hoiling got the kahard chain up and herit so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Sunday October 2nd 1864

First part of this 24 hours calm middle and later Part light breeze from the N E Cours S S E Impleid in hoiling and stowing down in the after hatch stowed down 57 blbs all sail set so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Monday October 3rd 1864

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N E Cours S S E all sail set at 2 P M home two Dil A A M kept of got in to the Strats at 9 A M Dased the diomed Islands at 9 A M Impleid in hoiling later part wind light cloudy weather saw ice under Cape east so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday October 4th 1864

First part of this 24 hours light wind from the S S E heading S W at 10 o'clock came ice like to Buss in to it holed every thing alack backed of it headed to the E Impleid in hoiling stowing down In the main hatch between decks later part light breeze from the N E heading S S E (along) the Whour sant Lorent bay full of ice so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 5th 1864

First part of this 24 hours light breeze from the N Cours S in herens streets at 8 P M. luffed low With the Main yard a lock lay till day light Saw plenty of devil fish toward 4 boats struck one drowed from him com on board kept of S Made all sail Impleid in hoiling braking out for Shooks saw ice saw the land sant Lorent Island so ends this day
