Remarks on Board Sunday October 30<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day light wind from the S.W. At 2 P.M. came to Anchor at Towhee Harbor later part Calm very warm some the crew on Shore so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday October 31<sup>st</sup> 1864

At this 24 hours fine weather laying at Towhee Bay Employed in getting of Shooks and provisions and Wood very warm so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 1<sup>st</sup> 1864

All this day fine weather Finest getting of Provisions and wood Shooks 15 lbs of Pork 15 Beef 2 Casks Flour 1 Molasses 12 Cords of wood later part Employed in washing ship out side got all ready for sea at 9 P.M. got under way Wind light so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 2<sup>nd</sup> 1864

First part of this day light wind from the S steering to the N.W. middle part wind from the N.N.W. heading to the W later part had the crabs warms in site so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday November 3<sup>rd</sup> 1864

All this 24 hours fine weather At 5 P.M. came at anchor In Honolulu Harbor so ends had 3 men sick cared hem a shore discharged them so ends this day

All this day fine weather Employed in landing shooks And Working Ship so ends this day

All this 24 hours fine weather Employed in drying bone And lurching it but one of the boat steers is Absent dis charged one man Joseph Francis took his things ashore so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday November 6<sup>th</sup> 1864

All this 24 hours fine weather laying in port Honolulu At hands a shore so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday November 7<sup>th</sup> 1864

First part of this day cloudy got home out to die at 10 P.M. had to put it below had rain squalls So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday November 8<sup>th</sup> 1864

First part of this day had a rain squall middle and later part fine weather Employed in drying and lurching Bone curing it a board John Wells of New Bedford so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday November 9<sup>th</sup> 1864

First part this day cloudy drying and lurching bone

Cared it all a board of the ship John Wells

158 bundles 182 31 lbs discharged 2 men 2 men

Whising a shore a farcor com on board took Mr. Youngs For learning the ship with out leaf so ends this day

All this day braking out shooks to carey a shore So ends this day

All this day fine weather braking out shooks cared them On Shores commenced packing ship dischard one man Mr. Youngs com on Board so ends this day
