

Remarks on Board Friday January 6th 1865

First part of this day light winds from the N^W heavy swell on got under way got over towards the mainland combs anchor payed out 175 fathoms of Chane started the works 4 boats of whaling burned one whale saw 4 whales all day
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday January 7th 1865
First part of this day fresh breeze from the W
Employed in hauling 4 boats of whaling later part
Rough Wind from the N^W so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 8th 1865
First part of this day strong winds from the N^W
Employed in hauling 4 boats of whaling
Finest hauling later part wind from the N^W
Two boats from turtle bay win one whale
Taken there 3 Ships there so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday January 9th 1865
First part of this day strong wind from the N^W
Later part so rough boats could not whale
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 10th 1865
First part of this day blowing strong from the N^W
Later part more moderate 5 boats of whaling
Saw several whales passing of shore bark I D
Thompson of New London Brown Master on to
Anchor here to day so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 11th 1865
First part of this day light winds from the North
Saw several whales 4 boats of whaling chased them
With boat sail I D Thompson struck one drowed
from him saw a bark beating to the windward
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday January 12th 1865

All this day Light wind from the N^W
5 boats of whaling saw good money whales passing
by raised a command cape Capt Brown boats
Struck it so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday January 13th 1865
All this day fine weather boats of whaling saw
Several whales passing but could not strike them
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday January 14th 1865
All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N^W
4 boats of whaling burned one whale did not
get him so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 15th 1865
All this day strong winds from the N^W
4 boats of whaling saw a command cap
Chased her could not strike her lost run of her
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday January 16th 1865
All this 24 hours strong winds from the N^W
Took hour anchor at 6 AM Steered down the
Coast S E saw 3 Ships laying in turtle bay
2 at Shantam Island bark I D Thompson
In company so ends this day
Laid 27, 28 N

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 17th 1865
First part of this day fresh breeze 4 boats of
Whaling saw plenty of whales running the land
down to the S E later part strong wind
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 18th 1865
First part of this day strong wind from the N^W
steering long the land to the S E saw whales
lowered but could not get ny them come on board
help of E bark I D Thompsons in company
So ends this day
