Chasing whals so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday January 20th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather 4 boats of whaling
Saw several whals very shi cant get on them
3 Ships in site whaling look in the labard boat
put out a nother had a man des put out one of
The men ford darted abrook in to his face
3 times coled all hands aft to find out how
don it the men said that Peter don it
put him in Sorns put him done in the
Main hack and made him part to the kne
With a chane so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday January 21th

All this 24 hours strong winds from the N^W
beating to the windard long the land All
hands in ploid in mending sails saw 2 ships
to theeward so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 22th 1865

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N^W
beating to the windard all sail set took the
Sorns of that man that had in irons so ends
this day Lat 25 44 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday January 23th 1865

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N^W beating
to the windard Impleid in mending sails
hent a forsail so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 24th 1865

All this day ~~fine~~ weather in to the land
4 boats of whaling whals very shi cant
Strike them saw bark Cantonpachet sailing
had 3 whals so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 25th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather light winds from the
South 4 boats of whaling got in under the land
Com to Anchor saw saw several whals could not
Strike them so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday January 26th 1865

All this day fine weather boats of whaling could
get on to the whals saw several going N^W
Wind from the South so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday January 27th 1865

All this day fine weather fresh breeze 4 boats of whaling
At 7 AM struck one killed him towed it to the
Ship cut it in 2 boats went of whaling again
Saw a few whals so ends this day

Remarks on Board on Board Saturday January 28th

First part of this day strong winds from the
N^W 4 boats of whaling impleid in hailing
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 29th 1865

First part of this day strong winds from the N^W
4 boats of whaling saw a few whals going N^W
2 gums going S so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday January 30th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the
N^W 4 boats of whaling middle part calm
later do saw quit good money whals could not get
on to them so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 31th 1865

First part of this day had honder storm from the
S E laying at anchor 4 boats went of whaling
At 10 blowing on ruged to whale com on board
Saw several whals wind S E got all ready
To slip double reefed the top sails so ends this day
