

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 15th 1865

First part of this day strong winds from the WNW
At 12 o'clock struck a whale run of shore
killed him 15 miles from the ship commenced towing
At sundown wind hauled to the N blowing a gale
of Wind had to leave the whale the whale
Sunk All night getting to the ship so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday February 16th 1865

All this day strong winds from the west & boats
of whaling struck a whale suna hup a hour he
killed him Just at dark shot him to the ship
at 3 o'clock in the morning so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday February 17th 1865

All this day strong winds & boats of whaling
Finest Boiling at dark saw a few whales
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday 18th February

All this day strong winds from the W
& boats of whaling saw a few whales just at
Night so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday February 19th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the
S W & boats went of at 9 AM blowing
A moderate gale with rain corn on board
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday February 20th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the
W at 1 o'clock & boats went in shore saw a
few whales at 4 o'clock blowed on a gale
Corn on board so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 21st 1865

First part of this day blowing strong from the W
& boats of whaling saw 4 whales & ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 22nd 1865

First part of this day light winds from the W
Middle and later part strong winds from S W with
rain Squalls & boats of whaling saw a few whales
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday February 23rd 1865

First part of this day light wind from the W with
rain Squalls took the Anchor Steved to the S
Middle and later part blowing strong double
reefed the top sails so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday February 24th 1865

All this 24 hours strong winds fair weather
Employed in working on rigging courses S
So ends this day Satt 23.29 N Long 113.41 W.

Remarks on Board Saturday February 25th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather light winds from the
NW Bore S all sail set Employed in working on
Rigging so ends this day Satt 21.26 N

Remarks on Board Sunday February 26th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather light winds from the
N Bore S all sail set so ends this day
Satt 20.28 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday February 27th 1865

All this day fine weather stowed down 40 lbs
oil at 8 AM raised land charens Island
At 1 PM got up to it raised pump hucks
loward struck two drowed from one cut
from the other at dark so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 28th 1865

All this day fine weather & boats of whaling
Just at night struck a whale run had
had to cut from him at dark 2 ships
Corn to day so ends this day
