All this day strong wind from the NNE
2 boats of saw few whals at 3 P M coled
the boats board started for the Sandwich Islands
Stowed the Anchors and chains a way
Catherine started for the Islands tow so ends
this day

All this day strong winds from the NNE
Cours W by S Impleid in washing ship
So ends this day Satt 18.22 N Song

Remarks on Board Sunday March 5th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the

later part fresh so ends this day Satt 18.20 N Song

All this 24 hours strong winds from the NNE
Cours W by S impleid in lashing spars and
other work so ends this day
Satt 18.13 N Song

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 7th 1865

All this day fine weather strong winds from the
ENE Cours W by S Impleid in working on rigging
So ends this day Satt 18.22 N Song

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 8th 1865

All this 24 hours strong winds from the E Cours W by S
Impleid in rathling down so ends this day
Satt 18.42 N Song 19.14 N

Remarks on Board Thursday March 9th 1865

All this day strong wind from the E Cours W
Impleid in rathling down so ends this day
Satt 19.02 N Song

Remarks on Board Friday 10th March 1865

First part of this day strong winds from the
E Cours W later part wind modart Impleid
In working on rigging how boat in on deck
Carpenter repairing her so ends this day
Satt 19.31 N Song

Remarks on Board Saturday March 11th 1865

All this 24 hours light winds Impleid in taring down
the rigging and working on rigging how boat on deck
Carpenter work on her Cooper making lungs
Cooper was helping the carpenter Capton com on deck
First I new tha was hooked to gether Capton got
The Cooper down coled for help I went and asked
The Capt wat it ment then whe had som
Words when tha got thru Capt coled me down
Below had a tork boat things that has him down
on the noige wat was the trouble with Cooper
And Capt was lost panting the daves Cooper told
him that he did not ship to part so ends this
day Satt 19.42 N
