Remarks on Board Wednesday April 12th

First part of this day light winds from
the E N E Cours W by W Employed

In mending sails so ends this day

Satt 25.22 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday April 13th

All this day light winds from the E
Cours W N W Employed in mending sails
So ends this day Satt 27.32 N

Remarks on Board Friday April 14th

All this 24 hours fine weather imploid
In ships duty so ends this day Satt
Long

Remarks on Board Saturday April 15th 1865

All this day fine weather Employed in ships

duty saw several fin backs Cours N W

Wind from S W so ends this day
Satt 30.55 N

Remarks on Board Sunday April 16th 1865

First part of this day light wind from the
S W Cours N W middle part wind fresh to
the N N E with rain fresh breeze later
Part no rain cloudy so ends this day
No Satt

Remarks on Board Monday April 17th 1865

First part of this day Strong winds from the
N N E Cloudy weather later part wind from the
N W heading N N E imploid in ships duty
So ends this day Satt 33.19 N Long 18105 E

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 18th

All this 24 hours light wind and calm
Employed in coiling lines for the boats
So ends this day Satt 34.33 N Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 19th 1865

First part of this day light winds from the S

Cours N W middle part fresh breeze later

part strong winds with rain saw 2 fin backs

So ends this day Satt 36.34 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday April 20th 1865

First part of this 24 hours strong wind from
the N N W heading N latter part calmer, double
beefed top sails took out stops and gin to the
hoen so ends this day No Satt Long

Remarks on Board Friday April 21th 1865

First part of this day strong wind middle part
wind light latter part calm Employed in
baking loam spun yarn so ends this day

Satt 39.09 N Long W

Remarks on Board Saturday April 22th 1865

First part of this day light wind from the S
Cours N W middle and later part strong wind
from the S W so ends this day
Satt 40.29 N Long W

Remarks on Board Sunday April 23th 1865

All this 24 hours strong wind from the W N W
heading to the N N W had rain squalls and hale squalls
So ends this day

Satt 42.23 N Long W
