First part of this day fresh breeze from the W
Clear all sail set in heavy ice working to the N
At 4 AM took in all sail ice closed close could not
get any further later part fine weather lay in the
ice chase several whals 20 sails in site so ends
this day Satt 61.28 N Long

Remarks on Board Sunday May 28th 1865

All this day fine weather laying in the ice all sail
In men going from ship to ship on the ice plenty
of whals in the ice cant lower about saw 29 sails
from mast head one boiling first part light are from
W later part wind E N E so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday May 29th 1865

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the N E laying
In the ice all sail in thick and rainy saw
Plenty of whals ice so heavy could not get aboard
down Implord in breaking out for water
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 30th 1865

All this day light are from the S E thick foggy
and rainy laying in the ice saw 4 whals to
day so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 31st 1865

First part of this day thick foggy in the ice
saw several whals made sail stand in to the
North ice closed so tide could not get any further
Took in sail several ships in site so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday June 1st 1865

First part of this day thick foggy with snow squalls
saw several whals at 7 AM one came up long side
pinned him killed him backward about got out on the
ice got a arrow in to him he sunk took the line
to the ship holed him up cut him in at 9 AM
Neither came up long side passed to him backward about
got on the ice holed him ice very heavy run the
line to the ship holed the boat on the ice to the ship
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday June 2nd 1865

This day in ploid in getting the whale to the ship
and cutting and boiling saw 5 boiling, but subsides
us 30 sails in site wind from the N E
Saw few whals ice heavy so ends this day
Satt 61 44 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday June 3rd 1865

First part of this day light are from the W
Clear 30 sails in site 6 boiling later part
Wind from the S thick foggy heard several whals
Implord in boiling so ends this day in the ice fast

Remarks on Board Sunday June 4th 1865

First part of this day light are from the
S E Implord in boiling raised a dead whale
two men started for it on the S came in thick
foggy could not find it came on board saw
2 ships take whals one was the whale that
We tried to get two saw ships whaling
So ends this day Satt 61 37 N

Remarks on Board Monday June 5th

First part of this day light wind from the
W at 3 PM the ice got luse so we steard to the
N E came in thick foggy Finest boiling Implord
In stowing down in the Main hatch stowed 135
lb so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday June 6th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the
N E laying drifting in the ice all sail in
Made fast to a large cake of ice saw 3 ships
boiling so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday 7th June 1865

First part of this day light wind from the
N E ice opened saw working to the N Implord
In breaking out for shoots raised a dead whale
to the windward got a boats to it got it to the ship
cut it in wind from the S W clear
30 sails in site so ends this day
