

Remarks on Board Sunday July 9th 1865

First part of this day light wind from the N W in the sea made sail worked out of it Got out in to clear water at 2 P M waited for the Tanny to get out then made sail steard for the head of the sound com to anchor at 6 P M of at the Island of Charnisso in 5 fathoms water Fanna Oliver Crocker Elisa Adams in company To get out of the way of the Shanordore first burning all the ships that he can catch so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday July 10th

First part of this day strong wind laying at anchor in Kotschue Sound at 11 P M

Ship Louisana coming in run on to a reef Struck hard broke the ruder boats went from all ships but the crew dis banded her and all the ships recked her later part Impleid in working on board So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 11th 1865

All this day fine weather Impleid in braking out the provision on board the reck So ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 12th 1865

All this day fine weather Impleid in getting Draft of water other things so ends

Remarks on Board Thursday July 13th 1865

All this day fine weather Impleid in braking out And stowing away things and provision com from the reck we had 2 1/2 lbs of Pork 9 lbs of Beef 2 3/4 of Flour 1 1/2 pipe of Bread 70 gallons of Molasses one Bag of beans after that got all of the things out of her some one set fire to her burnt her up so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday July 14th 1865

All this day strong winds from the S W laying at anchor in Kotschue Sound so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday July 15th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from S W Middle part the same later part light wind present Weather sent 2 boats to the reck got some iron work libel copier so ends this day Lat 66 16 N

Remarks on Board Sunday July 16th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather laying at anchor Some went a shore some a gaming so ends this day Lat 66 16 N

Remarks on Board Monday July 17th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the W present Weather Middle and later part blowing a gale from the W Laying at anchor in Kotschue Sound in 5 fathoms of water So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 18th 1865

First part of this 24 hours blowing a gale from W Middle and later part fine weather Impleid in shifting Sails and mending the Widen to galent sail So ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 19th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather 2 boats went to the Reck got some spars cut them up Coiled the whale line so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday July 20th 1865

All this day fine weather sent one boat out Side Impleid in fixing blocks bending sails So ends this day
