All this 24 hours fine weather Employed in getting
Hraft of water all Mad up the mires to
go out thinking that the Shanordore had gon
Sent about out sid gon 2 days com back to night
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday July 22nd 1865

This day commences with fine weather All 4 Ships
Got under way at 6 AM and beat out
With a fair tide later part wind light and pleasant
Weather on bent a for coars and bent a nether
Got 9 men on board that was recked in the Ship
Louisiana the 3 ofeer and boat steera 6 men Ford
one Cabin boy so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday July 23rd 1865

First part of this day fine weather light wind
From the W' Beating out Kotzebue Sound
At 10 AM com in thick fog All 4 Ships com to
Anchor of bay of good hope at 6 AM all got
Under way wind from W' beating out had clear
Fresh breeze so ends this day Lat 66.41 N

Remarks on Board Monday July 24th 1865

All this 24 hours clear weather fresh breeze from the
W' Middle and later part wind N' N' W

heading W' carrying all sail so ends this day

Lat 66.58 N

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 25th 1865

First part of this day light wind pleasant weather
Middle part Calm later part light wind from
S' Coars W' by S 3 Ships in company
Saw the land in to the S W' so ends this day

Lat 67.28 N Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday July 26th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze pleasant weather
heading to the W' later part thick with rain
So ends this day Lat 67.34 N

Remarks on Board Thursday July 27th

First part of this day strong wind from the
S 4 sails in site Spork Window harner
Strong wind with rain later part clear heading
W' E wind N' N' W all sail set 4 sails in site
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday July 28th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze fine weather
heading to the W' W' middle part heading S'
At 5 AM made the ice had it Calm at 9 AM
got a light are from the S S W' heading W'
later part wind from S' Coars W' by S 4 sails
In site all heading to the W' so ends this day
Lat 69.41 N Long 169.54 W

Remarks on Board Saturday July 29th 1865

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S steering N' E
long the ice thick fog so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday July 30th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the S thick
Fog steering N' E all sail set at 7 AM spork
Park Coral 7 Whals middle part Calm

Later part wind from the E N' E heading N'
thick with rain so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday July 31st 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the
E N' E heading N' thick fog at 4 AM com
to ice tacked ship at 6 AM wind hoked to the
South fresh breeze at 8 hoked the head yards
black lay all night at 9 AM lit up
Made sail at 11 raised a whale toward for it
did not seait from the boats com in thick fog
Com a board wind hoked to the N' E so ends
