

Remarks on board Tuesday August 1st 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N E
Thick fog at 2 P M lit up saw a sail to the
N E worked up to her Spoke her ontario 2 Whals
later part agale with thick fog carrying double reefed
Top sails standing tack and tack saw Ice so ends this day
Lat 50 10 N Long 169.00 W

Remarks on board Wednesday August 2nd 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E N E
Thick fog at 3 P M cleared of one sail in site
Heard of to the W at 8 P M com in thick fog
lay a back at 2 P M lit up braced fore

Stead to the W at 6 P M raised a whale

Loward chased it going fast to the W com on board

Stead of to the W so ends this day
Lat 50 07 N Long

Remarks on board Thursday August 3rd 1865

All this day thick fog by spells lit a little at times
Run to the W sum laying a back most of the time
So ends this day

Remarks on board Friday August 4th 1865

All this 24 hours light winds from N E
Thick fog laying a back most of the time
So ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday August 5th 1865

All this 24 hours light wind from the N N E
Thick foggy first part laying a back later part
Running of to the S W long the Ice so ends this
day Lat 50 36 N Long

Remarks on board Sunday August 6th 1865

First part of this day light wind from the
N N E Stearing to the S W later part clear
Stearing of to the S S W 6 Ships in site
All hauled to the S W long the Ice
So ends this day Lat 50.36 N

Remarks on board Monday August 7th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N E
Working to the S W 5 ships in site later part
Wind from the N E thick foggy byuls so ends this day
Lat 50 10 N Long 169.00 W

Remarks on board Tuesday August 8th

First part of this day fresh breeze from E N E
Running to the W Spoke Criele and gunnertrape from
The W ses that their ant him every Whals seen
that way so we worked back to the E 12 ships
In site all working to the E so ends this day
Lat 50 07 N

Remarks on board Wednesday August 9th 1865

All this day strong wind from the N E
Made a tack in to the Ice at 3 P M tacked ship
heading to the E stood on that tack all night
Bowed to the E shore saw the land
So ends this day Lat 69.26 N

Remarks on board Thursday August 10th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the N
heading E N E at 2 P M tacked ship land 15 miles
of stood of til 12 o'clock tacked ship heading E
had foggy byuls later part clear land in site
Coral in company so ends this day

Lat 69.27 N Long 163.24 W

Remarks on board Friday August 11th 1865

First part of this day strong winds from the N N W
Stood in to the land saw plenty of ducks
Loward got 20 stood of to the W N W
Feb 3 P M tacked ship at 6 P M raised
2 Whals loward chased them did not get
hold of them so ends this day
No Lat
