First part of this day blowing a gale from the N N W saw 2 Whals toward chert them could not get my them on board furl'd the Corces caring double reefed topsails later part lit more madart saw the Coral take a Whale So ends this day Satt 7006 Long 164 20 W

Remarks on Board Sunday August 13th

All this day fine weather saw 2 whals Struck one drowed from him later part working to the windard so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday August 14th

First part of this day fine weather at 6

P M rased whals toward got one cut him In later part hailing fine weather oricle In site so ends this day

Satt 6951 N Long 164.12 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 15th 1865

First part of this day light winds from the N at 6 P M saw a whale toward struck him drowed from him at 6 P M rased a Whale toward for him wind light and calm Chert him comin thick fogg struck him got him long side at 12 o'clock cut him in 2 Sails in site one whaling so ends this day

First part of this day fine weather wind S W com In thick fogg Impleid in cutting fin est cutting At 4 P M made all sail wind hoked to the N later part clear saw saw whals to the windard beating to the wind ard so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday August 17th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze rased whals to the Windard beat up to them toward struck one got him took him long side cut him in lost the head by leaning it over board made fast with a cotery fall parted middle part faggery later part clear no whals so ends this day

Satt 7007 N Long 163 34 W

Remarks on Board Friday August 18th 1865

First part of this day light winds from the W Drun of to the S W Spork oricle hailing Saw no whals to day Impleid in hailing

Later part thick fogg wind from the S

So ends this day No Satt No Long

Remarks on Board Saturday August 19th

First part of this day light winds from the S Thick fogg Impleid in hailing later part clear Impleid in Stowing down In the Fore hatch Choked of the Main hatch Saw 2 ships har ther houts down sowed down 143 lbs so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday August 20th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N Drun to the South sum then lift on the wind To the W land in site later part wind light Beating to the windard Spork Gounertrape hailing 2 Sails in site no whals Impleid in hailing So ends this day Satt 6935 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday August 21th

First part of this day light wind from the N beating to the windard middle part wind from E Stearing N by W at 9 P M rased whals toward chert all day calm could not get on them Sewerl Sails in site so ends this day
