

Remarks on Board Sunday September 3rd 1865

First part of this day saw several whals toward for them several times wind light later part fresh breeze from the N toward got a whale in the ice had considerable trouble to get him got him long side towed him out of the ice cut him in so ends this day Lat 70 34 N

Remarks on Board Monday September 4th

All this day ~~fine weather~~ strong winds from the N thick with snow squalls and fog

Employed in hoisting carrying short sails & whals in the blubber room under the lee of the ice

So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 5th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N thick fog Employed in hoisting and stowing down In the after hatch 146 later part wind light Spark bark Mercury 16 whals saw no whals today So ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 6th

First part of this day wind light and hailing round At 9 P M fresh breeze from S W at mid night from the S blowing a gale with snow Squalls Employed in hoisting later part more Modest plenty of ships in site ice in site So ends this day Lat 70 35 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday September 7th 1865

First part of this day strong breeze from the N Employed in hoisting stowing down in the after fore peak later part wind light plenty of ships in site saw some whaling ice in site so ends this day Lat 70 50 N

Remarks on Board Friday September 8th 1865

First part of this day strong wind from the N E Carrying double reefed top sails Employed in hoisting several ships in site staid up to the ice more ship heading E S E thick fog blowing agale so ends this day Lat

Remarks on Board Saturday September 9th 1865

First part of this day blowing a gale from the N E Closereefed the fore and mizen top sails under the lee of the ice Employed in hoisting braking out for water and starting it in to pipes saw a whale toward for him several ships in site later part calm so ends this day Lat

Remarks on Board Sunday September 10th 1865

All this day blowing agale from the N E Employed in hoisting and stowing down in the fore peak ice in site so ends this day Lat 70 54 N

Remarks on Board Monday 11th 1865

All this day fresh breeze from the N E saw several whals toward got one cut him in so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday 12th September 1865

All this day fresh breeze had snow squalls struck 2 whals drowed from them later part struck a natter got him make 5 lbs calf saw plenty of whals but could not get on them so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday Sep 13th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N N E Employed in hoisting later part blowing modest gale saw whals toward Chast thick last run of them so ends this day Lat 70 47 N Long 161 57 W

Remarks on Board Thursday Sep 14th 1865

All this day blowing a gale from the N E Employed in stowing down in the after hatch Choked the hatch of hoisting close to the ice 2 sails in site so ends this day Lat
