All this 24 hours laying of and on Honolulu waiting for a Carpenter at 12 o'clock Capt went a shore At 4 & 6 com of did not get eney Carpenter kep of to the W to get round warhoo then holed up to the W so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday December 7th 1865

All this day fine weather at 10 o'clock & 6 got past warhoo so as to hol up for the passy later part Employed in stow the Stanchars and Chans cleaning up the decks and other work So ends this day Lat 22.36 N Long

Remarks on Board Friday December 8th 1865

All this 24 hours fair weather Employed in washing Boats and repairing them ready for painting ships duty All sail set heading W W E so ends this day Lat 24.55 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday December 9th 1865

All this day fresh breeze from E heading W E Most of the time Employed in work on the stahard Boat other work so ends this day Lat 27.17 N

Remarks on Board Sunday Decem 10th 1865

All this 24 hours fine weather heading W E Wind from the E S E split the fly jib So ends this day Lat 29.06 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday December 11th 1865

All this 24 hours strong breeze with rain squalls Employed in getting boats ready for painting fixing the rigging so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday Decem 12th

All this day fresh breeze with rain squalls repaired the fore top galent sail jib and working at Boat so ends this day Lat

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 13th 1865

All this 24 hours Clear weather Employed in painting boats other work put the Stahard ham boat out So ends this day Lat 33.49 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday December 14th 1865

All this day strong winds from the E N E With rain squalls much Employed in making sinet and other work Cooper to work on a boat lashed ship once so ends this day Lat 33.46 N Long

Remarks on Board Friday December 15th 1865

First part of this day strong winds heading to the S E Later part heading to the W rain squalls now and then Employed in ripping up a old misen top sail and fitting Boats so ends this day Lat 32.59 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday December 16th 1865

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E N E heading to the W later part heading S E Employed in ripping up the old misen top sail mending the misen top galent sail so ends this day No Lat

Remarks on Board Sunday Decem 17th 1865

All this day strong wind from the E N E heading S E All sail set so ends this day Lat 33.12 N

Remarks on Board Monday Decem 18th 1865

All this day strong wind from the E N E first part heading to the W middle and later part heading S E Employed in mending sails bent a misen top sail So ends this day Lat 32.01 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday Decem 19th 1865

All this day strong winds from the N E heading E S E all sail set Employed in mending sail So ends this day Lat 30.00 N Long
