4 boats of whaling at 4 & 1/2 struck an whale
killed him got him long side at sundown got
super and cut him in later part calm
boats of so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 16th 1866
All this day light winds and calm saw plenty
of Whals 4 boats of struck one drowed from
him 2 ships in site one hailing so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday January 17th 1866
All this day light winds and calm 4 boats of
struck and drowed 2 ships in site implord
In hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday January 18th
First part of this day light winds and calm
4 boats of whaling finest hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday January 19th 1866
First part of this day fresh breeze from the N W
Implord in stowing down 2 boats of whaling
4 & 1/2 struck a whale got boat stove
lost the whale had to cut the other boat
lost the line so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday January 20th 1866
All this day fine weather Implord in whaling
4 boats of later part fresh breeze whals all going
Fast to the windard so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 21th 1866
First part of this day light winds fine weather
Struck a whale got him cut him in 2 ships
In site hailing so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday January 22th 1866

All this day fine weather light winds 4 boats of
Whaling; Saw few whals Implord in hailing
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 23th 1866
This day thick fog first part calm later part fresh
breeze clear Implord in hailing 4 boats of whaling
Saw a few whals going fast so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 24th 1866
All this day fine weather Finest hailing 4 boats of
raised a Cow and Calf Chased them 4 hours then struck
killed her got 2 boats stove took her long side cut
her in so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday January 25th 1866
All this day fine weather Implord in hailing 3 boats
of Whaling saw few whals going to the N
Fast 3 Sails in site one hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday January 26th 1866
First part of this day thick fog light air
Working to the N W saw few whals going to the
N so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday January 27th 1866
First part of this day light wind from the N N W
Implord in stowing down saw no whals
Later part wind S W heading W N W so ends
this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 28th 1866
First part of this day light winds 4 boats of whaling
Saw plenty of whals shiving round of glores lagoon
So ends this day
