All this 24 hours light air and calm struck 2
Whals line parted from one got one cut him in
Imploud in Bailing 2 sails in site to the W
Whaling So ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday ~~January~~ February 1st 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather Imploud in hailing
4 boats of whaling struck 2 whals soon broke
From one got the other cut him in So ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday February 2nd 1866

All this 24 hours weather good Imploud in hailing
4 boats of whaling struck one got him cut him
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday February 3rd 1866

First part of this day light winds fine weather
Imploud in Bailing 4 boats of whaling struck one
Got him cut him in latter part strong breeze from
N.W. So ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday February 4th 1866

First part of this day light winds Imploud in hailing
4 boats of whaling struck a whale kiled him
Sunke getting ragged could not hole him / up let
him lay all night boat lay by him all night
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday February 5th 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the N
holed a whale up that was had sunk took him long
Side cut him in 2 boats of whaling got 2 whals
got them long side cut them in So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 6th 1866

This day fresh breeze from the N Com to anchor of
Glenes lagoon 4 boats of whaling Imploud in hailing
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 7th 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the N
Struck 2 whals lost boath got one boat stove
lost line later part blowing fresh from the W
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday February 8th 1866

First part of this day strong winds 4 boats of whaling
Imploud in Stowing down broke a boat Steurer
Charles Sheres missed 5 whals for the seckend Mate
got a whale got him to the ship cut him in
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday February 9th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N
4 boats of whaling got a whale towed him to the
Ship towing all night strong wind from the N.W.
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday February 10th 1866

All this day fine weather 2 boats of whaling
Went up in to the Lagoon saw Cow and calf Chased
but lost her So ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday February 11th 1866

All this day fine weather 4 boats of whaling
Saw few whals in side of the reef
So ends this day
