All this day fine weather fresh breeze from the NE Cours W Impleid in setting up rigging
So ends this day Lat 19.40 N

Remarks on Board Sunday March 11th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather fresh breeze from NE Cours W all sail set
So ends this day Lat 19.50 N

Remarks on Board Monday March 12th

First part of this day strong wind from the E had rain Squalls Impleid in setting up rigging taking down the head-stays

So ends this day Lat 20.10 N

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 13th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E & E Cours W by S Impleid in braking out Shooks setting up for water taring down
So ends this day Lat 20.17 N Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 14th 1866

All this 24 hours light wind and Calm Impleid in working on rigging setting up Casks panting on deck aft
So ends this day Lat 20.32 N

Remarks on Board Thursday March 15th 1866

First part of this day light air and Calm Middle and later part fresh breeze from the NE Cours W by S Impleid in panting setting up Shooks
So ends this day Lat 20.32 Long 140 58

Remarks on Board Friday March 16th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather fresh breeze from the NE Cours W by S Impleid in panting the lower masts and dunnys setting up Shooks
So ends this day Lat 20.29 N Long

Remarks on Board Saturday March 17th 1866

All this day fine weather Impleid in in panting the yards and mast heads Cours W by S panting 2 boats over head
So ends this day Lat 20.28 N

Remarks on Board Sunday March 18th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather light wind from E Cours W by S
So ends this day Lat 20.24 N

Remarks on Board Monday March 19th 1866

All this 24 hours light wind from the E Cours W by S Impleid in ships duty
So ends this day Lat 20.20 N Long 141.18 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday March 20th 1866

All this day high wind present weather Impleid in ships duty
So ends this day Lat 20.25 N

Remarks on Board Wednesday March 21st 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather rose land All 9 AM up of oiler wind light
So ends this day Lat 20.28 N

Remarks on Board Thursday March 22nd 1866

First part of this day light wind from the NE

At 7 PM Com to Anchar at towhee bay Impleid

In braking out the after hatch hoping for the barrels of Wheat sent a raft a shore filed it
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday March 23rd 1866

All this day Impleid in getting of provisions from the shore got a raft of water broke out 112 barrels of oil out the after hatch Stowed a way meat in the after hatch
So ends this day
