

Remarks on Board Monday April 23th 1866

First part of this day light winds from the WNW heading N Middle part Calm later part fresh breeze from the S Cours NW by W Implode in Coiler line other work so ends this day

Sat 42.33 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday April 24th 1866

First part of this 24 hours strong wind from the S Cours NW by W later part thick with rain so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday April 25th 1866

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S W Cours NW by W later part thick with rain so ends this day Sat 47.53 N Long

Remarks on Board Thursday April 26th 1866

First part of this day light wind from the S W All sail set later part wind from the S light clear Implode in making lane Spun yarn so ends this day Sat 49.57 N Long 166.27 W

Remarks on Board Friday April 27th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the S S E Cours NW by W middle part took in top galent sails run til 6 AM clous reefed The top sails at 7 have two under clous

Reefed main top sails heading to the S S E

Blowing hard so ends this day Sat 51.56 Long 170.44 W

Remarks on Board Saturday April 28th 1866

First part of this day blowing agale from the W S W heading to the S at 6 PM blowed away the foretopstay sail bent a nother one at 7 o'clock Ware ship heading NW Sat the fore sail later part caring hull top sails raised the Land at 9 AM for Islands at 12 o'clock got up to the entrents of the passag had it squelley So end this day Sat 52.27 N Long 170.47 W

Remarks on Board Sunday April 29th 1866

First part of this 24 hours blowing strong from the W S W heading NW by W caring hull top sails at 3 PM double reefed the top sails at 5 PM got three The fore Island in to the hammatee sea later part Wind light heading NW W so ends this day Sat 54.29 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday April 30th 1866

First part of this 24 hours light wind from the W heading NW W Middle part Calm later part Fresh breeze from the S W Cours NW W later part clear so ends this day Sat 55.40 N Long

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 1st 1866

All this 24 hours blowing agale from the S W Cours NW W thick with rain so ends this day Sat 56.29 N Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 2nd 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the S W Cours NW W later part wind from the W heading NW W so ends this day Sat 59.23 N Long 177.51 W

Remarks on Board Thursday May 3rd 1866

First part of this day light wind from the W tacked ship heading S S W at 8 PM Tacked ship heading NW W light are later part tacked ship heading to the S S W So ends this day Sat 59.50 Long

Remarks on Board Friday May 4th 1866

First part of this 24 hours light wind from the W middle part wind from the S and calm later part wind from S W Cours NW W by W thick fog by Speks so ends this day Sat 60.05 N Long
