

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 16th 1866

First part of this day light wind from the S
Working round in the ice Impleid in hailing
At 6 P M wind haled to the N W blowed on
double reefed the top sails at 3 P M wind
haled to the N E blowing a gale with snow
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday May 17th 1866

First part of this day blowing agale from the
N E up to the ice at 4 took in the fore top
Sail Impleid in hailing at 6 P M more
modart set double reefed top sails thick snow
Storm worked in to the N W com to heavy
Ice then stud in to the E so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday May 18th 1866

First part of this 24 hours strong wind
from the N E with snow squalls Impleid in
sailing saw whals chas'd got one
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday May 19th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N E
had snow squalls working round the ice
Saw whals chas'd them so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday May 20th 1866

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from
the N E later part more modart
Impleid in Whaling so ends this day
