 week. We had some bad weather had snow squalls
 Some good weather 4 ships in site the
 last part of the week plenty of ice
 Round in flows in to the N^W and N^E
 Ice packed saw quite a show of whales
 Imploded in hailing so ends this last
 week

Remarks on Board Monday May 28th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather fresh breeze from the
 N^E Imploded in hailing 4 ships in site 2 hailing
 Later part run of to the S^W saw 2 sails spark
 bark whaling from the southward and saw only whales
 then we beat back to the N^E
 So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday May 29th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather Imploded in storming down
 Wind hailing 5 sails in site saw 2 cutting beating to
 the N^E in clear strips of water so ends this day
 Lat 63 04

Remarks on Board Wednesday May 30th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather working thru the
 Ice saw 2 ships whaling Imploded in hailing
 2 ships hailing so ends this day
 Lat 63.11 N

Remarks on Board Thursday May 31st 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N^W
 In the Ice saw one whale toward for him thick
 Snow storm Imploded in hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday June 1st 1866

All this day fresh breeze from the N^E Thick snow
 Storm saw one whale going to the North quick
 Imploded in hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday June 2nd 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N^E
 Saw clear water to the E of us made all sail
 got out of the Ice at 12 o'clock saw several
 Whales going quick to the North toward for them
 Imploded in hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday July 3rd 1866

All this day fine weather Imploded in hailing and
 storming down in the main back steering long
 the Ice to the N^E 4 ships in company 2 hailing
 So ends this day Lat 63.17 N
