So ends this day Lat 70.09 N Long 174.06 W

Remarks on Board Saturday July 28th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the
S-E running to the N-W 10 ships in site
Saw a whale toward for him com in thick
fog com on board Spork Ship Birch perry
Clear so ends this day Lat 6 70.82 N

Remarks on Board Sunday July 29th 1866

All this day thick fog laying a back
part of the time round the ice so ends this
day

Remarks on Board Monday July 30th 1866

First part of this day day light wind
From the S-E thick fog later part
Clear saw a whale toward for him
going to the windward quick 15 ships in
site Saw a take whals soave herels Island
bearing W distant 40 miles so ends this day
Lat 71.15 N Long 173.16 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday July 30th 1866

First part of this day fresh wind from the S-S-W
later part run of to the W-E saw whals
toward for them with out such ces saw 3 ships
boiling saw 15 ships so ends this day
Lat

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 1st 1866

First part of this day blowing strong with snow
Squalls saw whals chast com on board
later part saw whals toward got one
So ends this day Lat

Remarks on Board Thursday August 2nd 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the
S-W thick fog Implode in cutting later
part clear saw 20 ships 10 boiling
So ends this day Lat

Remarks on Board Friday August 3rd 1866

All this 24 hours strong winds from the S
At 6 P M double reefed the top sails started
The works saw to whals going to the windward
quick 30 ships in site several boiling
So ends this day Lat 70.55 N Long 170.17 W

Remarks on Board Saturday August 4th

First part of this day light wind from the
S-W Working to the W Implode Boiling
Saw 20 ships no whals so ends this day
Lat 70.49 N Long

Remarks on Board Sunday August 5th

First part of this day light winds from the
N-N-W heading to the W middle part Calm
later part light wind Implode in boiling
12 ships in site 4 boiling so ends this day
Lat 70.48
