First part of this day light wind from the NNE heading to the E At 7 AM raised whals to the windward worked up to them toward Star then got one blowing fresh from the NE cut him in thick with rain saw 20 Ships 2 hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 7th

First part of this day strong wind from the NE Employed in hailing and stowing down in the fore peack saw 3 Ships whaling Saw several running of to the S so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 8th

First part of this day light wind running of to the S at 5 PM com in thick fog left too with the head yards aback later part thick Employed in hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday August 9th

All this day light wind thick fog Employed in hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday August 10th 1866

Saw whals chase them saw president take one Ice in site so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday August 11th

First part of this day wind light saw whals chased them at 7 o'clock PM com on board All hands went on board Ship Reindeer after Shooks had the fore peack to break out for them Reindeer boats struck and got a whale When got the shark a board at 5 AM then went of whaling but the whals had gone of them com in thick fog so ends this day Latt

Remarks on Board Sunday August 12th 1866

First part of this day thick fog Middle part clear Employed in stowing down in the fore hatch 4 sails In site 2 hailing so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday August 13th 1866

First part of this day clear saw 2 whals toward take them lost run of them com on board Employed in stowing a w^h shooks in the fore hatch Thick fog so ends this day Latt

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 14th 1866

First part of this day light wind from the S thick fog middle and later part Calm

Ice in site 10 ships 3 hailing so ends this day
Latt 71.12 07 Long 169 41 77

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 15th 1866

First part of this day light wind from the S.E. Steering E NE at 6 PM left by the wind heading E Ice in site heading to the SE later part wind haled to the E com to Ice tacked to the NNE Thick with rain saw one sail so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday August 16th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the ESE heading to the S thick with rain later part Wind light from NNW heading to the W Saw 5 sails so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday August 17th 1866

First part of this day light wind from the NNW heading to the W long the Ice Saw 13 sails one hailing saw one cutting so ends this day Latt 71 02 07 Long 170.34 77
