First part of this day light wind from the N^W thick foggy Middle part Calm Saw several ships saw some whaling So ends this day Satt 70 51 N

Remarks on Board Saturday August 19th

First part of this day light wind from the ESE saw several whals toward chas with out such ces saw 2 ships take whals Later part thick foggy so ends this day

Monday

Remarks on Board Sunday August 20th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the ESE thick foggy Middle and later Clear wind NE Saw 2 whals Chas whals going quick Com a board so ends this day Satt 71.05 N Long 170.30

Tuesday

Remarks on Board Monday August 21st 1866

First part of this day strong breeze Clear Wind NE run of to the S at 7 o'clock P.M. raised a whale toward struck him and got him cut him in saw 4 ships cutting Later part thick foggy started the works So ends this day

Wednesday

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 22nd

First part of this day strong wind from the NE thick foggy Implode in boiling Later part lit up saw whals chas with out suckces so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 23rd

First part of this day fresh breeze from the NE thick foggy Implode in boiling ship Beandler whals Later part clear Saw a few whals toward chas one ship struck Whals went to the windard so ends this day Satt 70 55 N Long

Remarks on Board Friday August 24th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N^W Saw whals got one and cut him in Saw 4 ships cutting several whaling so ends this day Satt 70 50 N

Remarks on Board Saturday August 25th 1866

All this 24 hours Calm Implode in boiling Saw 2 whals toward for them lost run of them so ends this day Satt 70 40 N

Remarks on Board Sunday August 26th 1866

First part of this day Calm clear saw 2 whals Implode in boiling Later part thick foggy light Here from the N working to the windard So ends this day Satt 70 45 N

Remarks on Board Monday August 27th 1866

First part of this day light breeze from the N^W thick weather Implode in boiling and chocked Of the lower hole saw ships whaling Wind light so ends this day Satt 70 35 N Long 169 29 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday August 28th

All this 24 hours light wind working to the NE saw several ships saw one whale going quick to the NE Implode in boiling So ends this day Satt 70 39 N Long

Remarks on Board Wednesday August 29th

All this day fine weather Wind from the N^W Stearing to the NE Implode in boiling Finest boiling saw several ships going all Whals So ends this day Satt 70 50 N
