

Remarks on Board Sunday September 9th 1866

First part of this day blowing a gale from
The N thick snow storm carrying Claus reefed top
Sails running of to get out of the Ice at
7 P M took in the fore and mizen top sails
got out of the Ice helped two 2 ships in site
later part more norard sat double reefed top
Sails working to the windard so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday September 10th

First part of this day strong double reefed top sail
breeze from the N E thick fog later part more
modart Impleid in stowing down in the Main
hatch between decks steering to the N W
long the Ice so ends this day

Lat 70.45 so ends this

Remarks on Board Tuesday September 11th

First part of this day strong breeze from
The N E steering of S W Camilla in comp
At 9 P M seized a ship hauling left two
day will not at 7 A M hee of a gale
S W blowing a gale saw one whale
Saw several ships heading in to the N W
So ends this day Lat 70.13 N Long 153.20

Remarks on Board Wednesday September 12th

First part of this day blowing a gale from
The N E steering S W at 5 P M run in to
plenty of whals left two to ruged to lower
later part blowing a gale saw plenty of
Whal 7 ships in site so ends this day
Lat 69.51 N Long 174 19 W

Remarks on Board Thursday September 13th 1866

First part of this day blowing a gale from the
N E saw plenty of whals to the windard working
to the windard got up to them just at dark to late
time lower for them at 5 A M made all sail
At 8 saw whals toward and got one got him
long side sent 2 boats of a gale at 12 o'clock
Com on board commenced cutting several ship
In site all whaling saw one take a whale
So ends this day Lat 69.50 N Long 174.15 W

Remarks on Board Friday September 14th

First part of this day fresh breeze from the N E
Impleid in cutting later part light wind with
Snow squalls saw several whals toward east
but whals going quick so ends this day
Lat 69.51 N

Remarks on Board Saturday September 15th

All this day strong wind from the S E
Impleid in hauling whaling toward twice
whals on the go all ways 16 ships in site
Several hauling and whaling so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday September 16th

First part of this day fresh breeze from the
S E Impleid in hauling saw 3 ships whaling
later part wind light with snow squalls
so ends this day Lat 70.15 N Long 175.03 W

Remarks on Board Monday September 17th

First part of this day light winds from the E S E
later part wind from the North Impleid in hauling
steering of to the S E saw a few whals
going quick to the S E saw several ships steer
ing to the S E so ends this day
