

Remarks on Board Saturday September 29<sup>th</sup> 1866

First part of this day blowing agale laying to  
darsant run got a deck load of oil at 5<sup>th</sup> M  
kep of E S E Saw Ice Steard E by N  
thick snow Squels more nodart carling top galeno  
Sails so ends this day Satt 69.00 N Long 168.25

Remarks on Board Sunday September 30<sup>th</sup> 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the N W  
Steering S E at 4 P M spark bark Winding  
And bark Roscoe bound out at 7 o'clock light  
Ice heuling to the W At day light kep of S E  
later part wind light thick snowey weather  
Imploud in getting the chuns up 5 Sails in site  
So ends this day Satt Long

October 1<sup>st</sup> 1866

Remarks on Board Monday ~~September~~  
First part of this day light wind from the N W  
Cours S E by S got Shooks from the bark  
Roscoe later part wind S E Imploud in  
stowing down blowing agale thick snow  
Storm saw the land on the E Shoor  
So ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1866

First part of this day blowing a gale from the S E  
Cariny clous reefed main top sail thick snow storm  
later part wind from the N W stud in to  
9 fathoms of water them haled to the W water  
deepend had 30 fathoms thick snow storm  
hone two so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday October 3<sup>rd</sup> 1866

First part of this day thick snow storm at  
8<sup>th</sup> M lit up saw the diardneats kep of made  
kings Islands Imploud in hoiling saw 2 Sails  
at night remainder shourt sail wind from the N  
so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday October 4<sup>th</sup> 1866

First part of this day strong wind from the N  
Cours S by S Imploud in hoiling spark bark  
E lils Swift at night cared short sail so ends this day

Remarks on Board Friday October 5<sup>th</sup> 1866

All this 24 hours strong wind from the N  
Cours S by E Imploud in hoiling later double  
Reefed the top sails ~~so ends this~~ had a man die  
Thomas Falger age 38 belonged to Long Island  
haired him so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday October 6<sup>th</sup> 1866

All this day fine weather Imploud in stowing down  
and hoiling 4 Sails in site wind N E Steering  
S by E so ends this day Satt 58.00 N Long 169.42<sup>m</sup>

Remarks on Board Sunday October 7<sup>th</sup> 1866

First part of this day fine weather fresh breeze  
From the N E at 5 P M made Sant pauls Island  
At 7 took in sail lay til day light kep of S by E  
Run clous to the West end of the Island saw 3 Sails  
Imploud in hoiling later part blowing a gale  
took in fore and mizen top Sails so ends this day  
Satt 56.57 N Long

Remarks on Board Monday October 8<sup>th</sup> 1866

First part of this day blowing agal from the N E  
had to luf two on count of hoiling at 10<sup>th</sup> M  
Wind haled to the N kep of S by E Saw  
Several Ships Stearing to the S later part more nillat  
All sail Sat Imploud in hoiling  
So ends this day Satt 56.20 N Long
