All this 24 hours strong trade and squally
Caring top sails Main sail furled governor trape
In company so ends this 24 hours
Lat 15.20 N Long 154.27 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 12th 1866

First part of this 24 hours blowing strong
With rain squalls Course S by E governor trape
In company later part clear William Carter
has got the fever and ague had it when
he came on board then took him for it
So ends this 24 hours
Lat 15.28 N Long 154.27 W

Remarks on Board Thursday December 13th

First part of this 24 hours strong trade with
rain squalls at 10 P.M. wind hauled to the
S by E heading S by W had rain
squalls later part Capt went on board
Ship governor trape bent a new Main top
gale sail so ends this day Lat 6.00 N

Remarks on Board Friday December 14th 1866

First part of this day fresh breeze with rain
squalls at 12 o'clock at night tacked Ship
heading N by E at 3 P.M. tacked Ship
heading S by W Implaid in painting boats
other work so ends this day
Lat 4.41 N Long 154.32 W

Remarks on Board Saturday December 15th

All this 24 hours clear weather wind from the
E by S heading S by E Implaid in Ship's duty
governor trape in company so ends this day
Lat 2.54 N Long 154.04 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 16th 1866

All this 24 hours fine weather fresh breeze from the
E Course S by E at 11 P.M. passed Christmas Island
At 4 P.M. Capt went on board governor trape
So ends this day Lat 10.22 N Long 155.50 W

Remarks on Board Monday December 17th 1866

All this 24 hours strong winds from the E S E
Course S by E governor trape in company
Implaid in Ship's duty so ends this day
Lat 2.50 S Long 155.55 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 18th 1866

All this 24 hours strong winds from the E S E
Course S by E Implaid in putting out 2
Sahard boats and getting them ready for whaling
governor trape in company so ends this day
Lat 6.23 S Long 156.22 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 19th 1866

All this 24 hours strong wind from the E
Course S by E & E Implaid in turning in the fore
Bigen and other work governor trape in company
So ends this 24 hours Lat 9.41 N Long 155.59 W

Remarks on Board Thursday December 20th 1866

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the E
Course S by E & E passed Islands in the night
Implaid in turning up the fore Biggering other work
later part S Course S governor trape in company
So ends this day Lat 12.25 N Long 156.03 W

Remarks on Board Friday December 21th 1866

All this 24 hours light wind from the
N by E Course S by W & W Implaid in turning
in rigging and other work making ajile boom
So ends this 24 hours Lat 14.25 Long 156.54
