First part of this 24 hours light wind and pleasant weather. Course S S W. Later part rain storm wind from the S S W heading S E governor trape in company so ends this day
Lat 22.34 S Long 159.40 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 23th

First part of this 24 hours light air from S E Course S W by S & S middle part fresh breeze from the N. clear later part had rain squalls governor trape in company so ends this day Lat 16.34 S Long 155.58 W

Remarks on Board Monday December 24th

First part of this day light baffling winds with rain squalls middle and latter part clear with a fresh breeze from the S E Course S W by S & S governor trape in company so ends this day Lat 18.10 S Long 159.26 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday December 25th 1866

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S E Course S S W at 10 P M raised the land Whytack lay a back till day light run round to the W of the Island 2 boats went a shore got 2 boat loads of wood and got prute so ends this day Lat 18.50 S

Remarks on Board Wednesday December 26th

First part of this day fresh breeze from the E S E laying off and on at Whytack at 7 P M Capt Com on board steard of S by E governor trape in company later part fresh breeze Impleid in ships duty so ends this day Lat 21.36 S Long 159.40

Remarks on Board Thursday December 27th 1866

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the E heading S S W Impleid in working on riggin and other work at 6 P M up to oratory governor trape in company later part wind light so ends this day
Lat 22.34 S Long 159.40 W

Remarks on Board Friday December 28th 1866

All this 24 hours light wind from the E heading S S E Impleid in sending out a jib boom so ends this day Lat Long

Remarks on Board Saturday December 29th 1866

First part of this 24 hours light wind middle part fresh breeze from the E heading S S E later part wind light Impleid in working on rigging so ends this day
Lat 26.21 S Long 159.22 W

Remarks on Board Sunday December 30th 1866

All this 24 hours light wind from the W Course S E governor trape in company All sail set so ends this day
Lat 27.40 S Long

Remarks on Board Monday December 31th

First part of this day light wind from the N W Course S E drisley rain governor trape in company gaming Impleid in taking up shitting so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 1st 1867

All this 24 hours light wind from the E N E Course S E rainey Impleid in taking up shitting Capt went on board governor trape so ends this day
