Wind from the S W all sail set fine weather
In plow in mending sails got troupe in site
So ends this day Latd 41.33 S Long 141.13 W

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze and fine weather
Wind W S W Cours E by S middle part squally
Took in top gablets sails latter part all sail set
Clear so ends this day Latd 42.24 S Long 136.58 W
in site
got troupe

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 16th 1867

First part of this 24 hours blowing agale from
the W S W latter part wind W all sail out
got troupe went out of site a storm had rain
squally Cours E by S so ends this day
Latd 43.25 S Long

Remarks on Board Thursday January 17th 1867

First part of this 24 hours blowing agale from the
W Cours E by S all sail set latter part more
modart meat hole so ends this 24 hours
Latd 43.33 S Long 128.12 W

Remarks on Board Friday January 18th 1867

All this 24 hours blowing a gale from the W.
Cours E by S curing all sail so ends this day
Latd 46.01 S Long

Remarks on Board Saturday January 19th 1867

First part of this day blowing a gale
from the W N W at 6 P M took in roils and
top gablets sails At 6 P M double reefed the
top sails at 11 P M took in main sail had sea
in plenty of rain so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday January 20th 1867

First part of this 24 hours agale from the N W Cours E by S
Thick with rain curing double reefed top sails at 2 wind haled to
the W and died away clear of at 4 wind W S W Cours
E at 7 P M made all sail wind light lary sea on
latter part pleasant so ends this day
Latd 48.58 S Long 114.53 W

Remarks on Board Monday January 21th 1867

All this 24 hours fine weather fresh breeze from the W N W
Cours E all sail set Employed in craping pick of the
deck so ends this day Latd 50.03 S Long 109.26 W

Remarks on Board Tuesday January 22th 1867

First part of this day strong wind from the N W
Cours E 1/2 N all sail out middle part rainey with
squally latter part wind from the W and clear
all sail set so ends this day Latd 51.05 S Long 104.18 W

Remarks on Board Wednesday January 23th 1867

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the W to the S W
haling Cours E by N fine weather all sail set
Employed in noting yards for spungarn so ends this day Latd
51.43 S Long 95.11 W

Remarks on Board Thursday January 24th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the W all sail
set middle part wind from the N W with rain
Latter part wind W N W Cours E by N all sail set
Thick and rainey so ends this day Latd Long

Remarks on Board Friday January 25th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the W
With rain all sail out middle part wind W S W
latter part wind W clear so ends this 24 hours
Latd 53.00 S Long 88.31 W
