All this 24 hours fine weather Impleid in cooping oil between decks so ends this day

Remarks on Board Thursday February 7th 1867

All this 24 hours fine weather finest cooping oil between decks so ends this day

Remarks on Board February Friday 8th

All this 24 hours fine weather Impleid in Washing Ship and took awaft of casks a shower fell it so ends this day Steward wash a shower so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday February 9th

First part of this day fresh breeze from the S W took the Anchor dropped down to sparer come to get water Steward wash a shower so ends this day

Remarks on Board Sunday February 10th

All this day fine weather fresh breeze laying at anchor at sparer come all hands on Board so ends this 24 hours so ends this day

Remarks on Board Monday February 11th 1867

All this 24 hours strong winds from the W took hour Anchor went to sea stowed the Anchors and chane took Mr Mcure on board had left back John H rob of Sag harbor so ends this day

Remarks on Board Tuesday February 12th

First part of this day strong wind from the W Coars N by W Cariny double reefed top Sails Middle part more modert later part all sail set At 10 AM raised Sperm whals toward for them going quick to the windard did not see them from the boat com a board run of 4 miles then left on the wind beat to the windard so ends this day

Remarks on Board Wednesday February 13th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S heading to the windard at 5 PM kep of N At 9 took in sail at day light kep of W made sail fine weather Impleid in mending sails so ends this day Lat 47.27 S Long 56.43 W

Remarks on Board Thursday February 14th 1867

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the NE heading to the N W Impleid in mending fore top sails bent it so ends this 24 hours

Remarks on Board Friday February 15th 1867

All this 24 hours fresh breeze from the NNE heading to the N W Spork the goutrape of men Bedford she had lean sperm whals 2 times latter part thick with rain so ends this day

Remarks on Board Saturday February 16th

First part of this day blowing agale with rain At night took in sail at 5 AM cleared of Made sail Impleid in mending sail so ends this day Lat 45.43 S Long 57.35 W

Remarks on Board Sunday February 17th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fine weather wind from the S W Coars N by W in company with goutrape of latter part modert gale cariny top sails took in sail at night murning set top sails running of N so ends this day Lat 44.13 S Long 56.41 W

Remarks on Board Monday February 18th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S W Coars N at night shortened sail run all night at day light made sail at 4 past 5 AM raised sperm whals slowart 2 boats whals going to the leward labard quarter Boat went on darted 2 Sarns hit the whale far did not go in bent them up Steward quarter boat toward but the whals of went on had one missed them the whals started of Chast but could not get ny them comon board so ends this day Lat 42.08 N Long 56.41 W
