All this 24 hours Calm Employed in mending
Sails Saw 3 Sails so ends this day
Lat 31° 00' S Long

Remarks on board Saturday March 2nd 1867

First part of this day wind from N E
heading N N W at 11 P M tacked ship heading
E S E later part fresh breeze from the same
Employed in mending Sails so ends this day

Remarks on board Sunday March 3rd 1867

First part of this day wind N E fresh breeze
All sail set later part took in top galant
Sails cours E by N saw several sails steering to
the S W so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday March 4th 1867

First part of this day strong wind from the W
Cours E N E set top galant sails Main rail
Saw seven sails later part wind S W and light
Employed in shocking tacks so ends this day

Remarks on board Tuesday March 5th 1867

First part of this day light wind from the
S E Cours E N E middle part Calm and rainey
later part light wind from the E N E
heading N so ends this day No Lat

Remarks on board Wednesday March 6th 1867

First part of this 24 hours light wind from the
E S E heading N N E rainey later part light
Wind and Calm heavy rain so ends this day
No Lat

Remarks on board Thursday March 7th 1867

First part of this day Calm with rain at 3 P M
got abress from the N E heading E S E middle
and later part clear Employed in ships duty
So ends this day Lat 29° 12' Long 35° 10' W

Remarks on board Friday March 8th 1867

First part of this day strong wind from N N E
heading E Employed in ships duty later part
Wind light so ends this day

Lat 28° 04' S Long 34° 30' W

Remarks on board Saturday March 9th

First part of this day light wind fine weather
Employed in setting up rigging and other work
Saw 2 sails later part fresh breeze from the N N E
heading E so ends this day
Lat 28° 07' S Long

Remarks on board Sunday March 10th 1867

First part of this 24 hours fine weather heading
E S E at 8 P M wind holed tacked ship
heading N wind light 2 sails in site
So ends this day Lat 27° 37' S Long 30° 48' W

Remarks on board Monday March 11th 1867

First part of this day light wind from the
E N E heading N Employed in taking out
board and stowing it back later part strong
Wind from the E N E head N 2 sails in site
So ends this day Lat 25° 50' S Long

Remarks on board Tuesday March 12th 1867

First part of this day Strong winds from the
N E heading N N W at 7 P M tacked ship
heading E S E Employed in taking out
board and stowing back so ends this day
Lat 24° 25' S
