From the N W heading NNE Implied in
boiling at 9 P M had to cool down took in
Fore and Main top sails latter part more moderate
Set close reefed top sails started the warbs (how far
Saw several sails so ends this day (did they go
Lat 39 18 N Long 70.30 W

Remarks on Board Friday April 19th 1867
First part of this day blowing agale from the
N N W heading NNE at 10 P M finest boiling
Set but top sails at 11 o'clock tacked ship
heading N by N later part strong breeze fine weather
hove the trawls over board stowed down the oil
Washed off saw several sails so ends this day
Lat 39.30 N Long 70.46 W
