breeze from S and good weather, steering N.W. by W carrying all sail, This morning we past 2 ships steering to the S.E. Through the day the wind hauled to N.W. and headed up off N. Wind light & fine weather, blue water, saw plenty of Finbacks & Porpoises, Made a forge for the blacksmith, Cooper finished the new grind stone tub

Friday Jan 14th

Lat by obs 51, 31 Long by Ch 81, 08 W

Begins with light wind from N.W. and fine weather, heading upon opposite tack, middle part of the day calm, At 1 P.M. took a breeze from S.W. and steered N.W. by W. All sail set, saw plenty of Finbacks & Porpoises, blue water, At 4 P.M. came up with from the S.W. Took in galled sails, I am making me a boat sail, Carpenter making a grating for the deck under the tiller, Cooper making bungs

Lat by obs 50, 43 Long W by Ch 81, 18

Saturday Jan 15th

Strong gales from S.W. through the night, steering N.W. by W, In the morning blowed heavier in squalls, reefed the topsails & steered N.W. by N. all day, Latter part of the day wind S.W. Saw plenty of Finbacks, blue water, clouds of the sea falling A ship & a brig past us steering to the S.E.

Lat by obs 47, 31 S Long W by Ch 82, 25

Sunday January 16th Fresh breeze from

N.W. to W and good weather, heading from N.W. to N.W. carrying all sail, saw nothing, blue water, This morning a ship past us steering to the S.E.

Lat by obs 44, 25 Long W by Ch 83, 20

Monday Jan 17th

Light wind from S.W. by W to W and good weather, some foggy in the morning, heading N.W. to N.W. carrying all sail, saw one Finback, Employed in 2 large mats, Cooper making bungs, Carpenter making slats for a rack for the tiller

Lat by obs 41, 53 Long W by Ch 84, 08

Tuesday Jan 18th

Light wind from S.W. and fine smooth weather, steering N.W. by W carrying all sail & topmast sliding sail, saw a school of grampoids, Employed in making spungern & 2 large mats for riding to anchor Cooper making bungs, Carpenter making a rack for the men to stand on at the helm

Lat by obs 39, 45 S Long W by Ch 85, 42

Wednesday Jan 29th

Light wind from S and fine weather steering N.W. by W carrying all sail, blue water saw nothing, but the carp clicking blacksmith blacksmithing, Cooper making bungs, Carpenter making a rack, Witches making mats, & spungern, I making a boat sail

Lat by obs 37, 35 Long by Ch 87, 14
