Cubber for a Slope rail, Black Smith making
Hoops for the main braces and Steering braces

Sunday Feb 16th

Moderate wind from E to ESE and
fine weather, Steering NW by N Carrying all sail,
Saw a Finback, Hauled the Cutting Galls, and aired
them Steerage boy is very sick with his stomach
swelled up, One of the Boatswain has a swelling under
his arm and has come to a head with a boilice & I lanced it

Monday Feb 17th

Moderate wind from E to ESE and some
rain squalls, Steering NW. Carrying all sail, Saw porpoises
2 Finbacks and caught a Porpoise, Employed on the rigging
Tarring down the rigging, Cooper made a water keg for
my Boat, Black Smith blacksmithing, Carpenter made a
check to go on the Starboard side the rail, for the main
sheale

Tuesday Feb 18th

Last night Moderate wind from ESE, this
morning strong wind, with rain squalls from E and
rugged weather, latter part of the day moderated and thick-
ened up like rain, Employed on the rigging,
Steerage boy sick

Wednesday Feb 19th Light wind from E to ESE and

some showers, Steering NW by N, All sail set,
Employed on the rigging, Tarring up the belings on
the topmast rigging and Tarring down, fixed the
Patent Cutting Stage & Black Smith making the
iron stentions to the Cutting Stage, Packed on the Gun rails
on to the fore and main rigging, Caught a Porpoise
last night, Steerage boy no better, At 6 P.M. came
up heavy showers of rain, with thunder and lightning

Lat by obs N 6, 36 Long by Ch 129, 00

Thursday Feb 20th

Last night heavy squalls of rain,
thunder & lightning and some wind from SE to ESE
Carrying whole top sails, fore noon calm, After noon
breezed up from NE, Big swell from NE Broke
out water and 3 Casks of Shookes ready for putting up
Shookes for fresh water, 15 pair of heads, a cask and
45 Casks all told, Carpenter making pin rails for
the main rigging, Black Smith finished shortening
the Cutting Stage stentions

Lat by obs 7, 58 Long by Ch 130, 07

Friday Feb 21st

Last night light wind and rain squalls
from the NE, Through the day fresh breeze from
NE and good weather, Steering NW by N Carrying all
sail, Employed on the rigging, Cooper setting up new
Shookes for fresh water, Carpenter made plugs to plug up
the pumps, Black Smith making holes for fresh water
buckets, & made some big rails for making on slide boards
