

Friday March 6th Sea breeze through the Day & Land breeze through the Night. Took on shore some Shookies and Flour in the Store House, the Bread and Flour and some of the Shookies, the Nautilus & the California came in here to anchor, Mr Cornway measured up our Potatoes, We have taken aboard 1150 lbs of Shookies.

Saturday, March 7th Fresh sea breeze and some rain, took aboard our Potatoes 93 lbs at \$3.50 finished taking on shore our stuff, then put aboard Schooner Merilda 433 galls of sperm oil, to be carried to Honolulu for \$50 Cts per bbl. Took 3 Casks of Sails on shore.

Sunday March 8th Light airs and Calm, fine weather, Larboard watch went on shore on Liberty, I spent part of the Day on board Gayhead, & I went on board the California. All came aboard at night.

Monday March 9th Fresh sea breeze and fine weather. Finished taking our stuff on shore, and showed it all in the Store House, Left the Anchor along side the Prison, & 3 Sack Casks in the Potatoe House & 2 Casks of Cordage in the back Store & 4 Cases of Tobacco & 8 half boxes of Tobacco in the back Store, We have taken in all 100 lbs of Potatoes at \$3.50 per bbl. At 4 P.M. I came off all ready for sea & have short

Tuesday March 10th Last night at 12 o'clock, we hoisted a light breeze from S, so we have short & set all sail and took the anchor & stood out of Towahoe Bay in company with Ship Gayhead, At 11, Had a good run through the Bay, Run out sight of the Gayhead, Saw 2 Schooners & 2 Ships saying off and on, At 6 P.M. Close to Waahoe, Shortened sail and stood off, Took the anchor off on the bow, So ends this Day in Waahoe Passage.

Wednesday March 11th Strong trade wind and fine cool weather with Showers of drizzle rain, At 8 in the morning, I went on shore and sent my boat off with the letters, Ship stood off and on and I staid on shore all night & visited Capt Kelly & Lady & Capt Rose and Lady, Shipped 3 Men and discharged the Steerage Boy.

Thursday March 12th Strong trade winds and Showers, Ship standing off & on, Several ships standing off and on, Myself on shore at Honolulu & staid all night, spent the evening with Capt Rose.

Friday March 13th Strong trades and Showers and fine weather, Ship laid off and on, At 5 P.M. I came aboard with a shoe boat, 2 bbls of Sugar for my self & 1 bbl for the Ship & 1 gallon of Brandy & 1 bbl of ale for the Ship, brought 3 Men on board. Sent the Steerage Boys things on shore, At 6 P.M. Steered off to the W.S.W. for Hiloai, I went on board the Rain Deer in the Harbor.
