

We run to the S.W. till dark then Luffed too for the night. All hands stowing down oil in the fore hold and bailing and hauling up oil and broke out Shekes.

Lat by obs 70° 22' Long by Ch 163° 13'

Thursday Oct 1st

Strong gale from N.E. and Rugged weather, Laid too last night. At 5 in the morning steered off S by W by W and set double keels topsails, Hellen Mar in company, saw several ships past & by the wind and saw one running off with us. All hands broke out for slops and a bailing & hauling up oil out of the blubber, Rugged bailing and blowing on.

Lat by obs 168° 30' Long by obs 167° 00'

Friday Oct 2nd

Strong gale from N.E. to N by E and Rugged, Laying too on the starboard tack, heading from N.E. to E by N. Carrying a close reefed main topsail and staysails. Progress and Hellen Mar close by. Ship lies well on her side and we are stowing out oil slowly, filled several casks of oil bailed up from the blubber room, blubber is running out bad & can't keep much oil in the fore to boil, no whaling to be seen. Broke the mincing machine and repaired it.

Lat about 168° 10' Long by acct 167° 30'

Saturday Oct 3rd

Strong gale from N.W. and Rugged weather, heading West, carrying double keels main topsail and staysails, All hands stowing down oil in the fore hold and hauling up oil that runs out of the blubber. The oil is over the ground tier, half the oil out of the blubber, spoke Hellen Mar, she will stand to the west to night. No whaling employed in bailing, saw a porpoise steering S.E. and the progress by the wind.

Lat about 67° 00' Long about 167° 00'

Sunday Oct 4th

Light wind from N.E. and good weather heading W and carrying all sails, Hellen Mar in company, In the morning I went on board the Hellen Mar and got a bbl of sand and a piece of fresh pork, employed in bailing and hauling up oil, and stowing oil in the fore hold, broke the mincing machine and I kept the lubbers to mince by hand, latter part of the day calm and Capt Herandean came on board and spent the evening with me.

Lat by obs 68° 45' Long by Ch 172° 00'

Monday Oct 5th

Fresh breeze from S and fine weather, In the morning we steered off N.W. by W and heeled out 2 N.W. and then saw 2 ships whaling to the S.W. of us, then the Lulian took a whale. Call the other ship the Champion, At 2 P.M. we saw several whales and the Hellen Mar chased all the latter part of the afternoon. Saw the whaling working off to the N and saw white fish working the same way, saw a Carke, plenty of birds, dark green water, employed in cleaning out the fore hold and stowing 6 casks of oil and 2 of water, At dark Capt Herandean spoke me.

Tuesday Oct 6th

Light wind from S and fine warm weather. Saw several whales working off to the N, fore noon we worked to the S, saw ice to the S.W. of us, saw the Lulian cut a whale, spoke Hellen Mar, latter part of the day we ran off to the N, At 3 P.M. we lowered and got a whale along side in the night and stowed off the fore hold and commenced to cut our whale, saw a boat to the N of us,
