

Wednesday Nov 4th First part Light variable airs and Calm with Rain, Latter part light wind from N.W. Steering S.E. by S. All Sail Set, Watched Scraping Bone. In the night breezed up fresh and hauled Mast

Thursday Nov 5th First part fresh breeze from W. Latter part wind light and variable from W to N.W. good weather & All Hands Scraping Bone and finished Scraping and put Bone to Soak at night for washing Made off Duty and I am off Duty with a Bail on my Choke Bone, Steering S.E. by S

Friday Nov 6th First part light wind from N.W. Latter part fresh breeze from N.E. fine weather, Steering S.E. by S. All Sail Set, All Hands washing Bone, Made a Bone bin on Deck, At night put Bone on Deck to Soak, Saw a Finback.

Saturday Nov 7th Strong gales from N.E. and Rugged weather, Steering S.E., Hauling reefed topsails & Courses & Sea broke in to the Lib and burst it to pieces, without the fragments, Thrown below the Bone that was to Soak Turned over the Starboard Boat

Sunday Nov 8th Strong gales from N.E. and Ship Roking the lee rail under water & taken in a great deal of water down the hatch, Pumped Ship most the Day and did not freshen Steering S.E. by S. Carrying Double Reefed topsails & Courses, Bent an old Lib, Cloudy weather, Plenty of Birds

Monday Nov 9th Strong gales from N.E. & N.E. and Squally, Steering S.E. by S and S.E. part the time, Part the time Carrying all sail and part the time whole topsails, Stranded the lower Bobstay and we put on a Preventer, I think that these N.E. only winds reaches to the Trades and well North there,

Lat about 34, 10 Long about 161, 10

Tuesday Nov 10th Strong gales from N.E. and Rugged weather & a big Sea from N.E., Steering S.E. by E Carrying Double Reefed topsails & Courses, Bent the fore Staysail out of the Lib and Set the Staysail for a Storm Sail,

Lat by obs 32, 00 Long by Ch 159, 10

Wednesday Nov 11th Strong wind from N.E. by E and heavy squall of wind and Rain, Steering S.E. by E, Carrying Reefed topsails and Courses, Saw the fore topsail and repaired it, Got out water, Latter part washed Bone Bone, Made off Duty, yet

Lat by obs 29, 45 Long by Ch 157, 35

Thursday Nov 12th Fresh breezes from E.N.E. and fine weather Steering S.E. & Carrying all sail, Came up with a Brig and past her, Brig Steering for Point More Southerly, All Hands employed in washing Bone, Stevedore washing Cabin, Tooke down the Stoves

Lat by obs 27, 24 Long by Ch 155, 19

Friday Nov 13th Light wind from E.N.E. and good weather, Steering by the wind upon opposite tacks by the wind Carrying all sail, Saw a Finback, All Hands washing Bone Bent the Lib, Made new Lib Standards, Washing the Cabin, Only one hand to wash now Lat by obs 25, 19 Long by Ch 153, 10
