

Sight to the South along the ice, some of them
a gaming, Saw the Concorda lower for Walrus, the
Walrus are quite sleepy. Lat about 68, 00

Thursday July 22nd

Light wind from N and fine weather
Worked on to the Western ice and saw a big show of
Walrus in the ice & on the ice. Sent the boats and
caught 41 and lost 8 off them. Several ships & Walrus
in this ice, Land in sight to the S.W. plain

Lat by obs 67, 37

Friday July 23rd

Fresh breeze from West and some snow
squally, Beat into West through the ice, 11th in
the morning, all the boats went off Walrusing and at
night brought 40 Walrus to the ship. Saw great
quantities of Walrus on the ice, Walrus working
to the West in to the pack, Pack ice to the N & S
of us, Cape Serdige plain in sight to the S.W. and
ice all the way in shore, 4 ships were catching
Walrus.

Lat by obs 67, 23

Saturday July 24th

Light wind from S in the fore noon and
some foggy, The ice in a light of ice 30 miles N of Cape Serdige
and sent our boats off Walrusing & caught 20, We worked
out of the ice, latter part of the day light wind from N.W.
Saw plenty of Walrus in the ice, Florida Bay 47th Walrus
Concorda Bay 375 & we have 160 Walrus.

Sunday July 25th

Begins with fresh breeze from
West and good weather, In the morning, all 5 boats
went in the ice a Walrusing and brought to the
ship 42 Walrus, Saw thousands of Walrus and
several ships boats catching them, great many
Walrus to sleep on the water, The Walrus
work now to the N.E., Several ships in sight,
Spoke the Florida 525 Walrus, Spoke the Concorda
380 Walrus, Spoke the Daniel Webster 360
Walrus, Latter part of the day took a fresh
breeze from S.E. and took like bad weather,
Natives came off enboard of us, 25 miles from land

Cape Serdige about 30 miles off
to the South West and plenty
of ice in shore

Monday July 26th

Fresh breeze from S in the morning, all
our boats went off Walrusing & caught 41 Walrus,
The Natives left us this morning, plenty of Walrus &
Wilde, We have now 343, Land in sight to the S.W.
is Cape Serdige, The shore ice makes off a long way from
land

Lat by obs 67, 15

Tuesday July 27th

Begins with fresh wind from East and
foggy, Cleared up in the morning, sent in all 5 boats and
caught 33 Walrus, plenty of Walrus and very wild,
Danish Webster, Concorda, Florida, & Julian have Walrus
ice packing up with this Easterly wind, Cape Serdige
about 15 miles off, plenty of bowheads about here, ...
Cruiser from the ship against the ice and knocked off a slide
board
