

Sunday Oct 14th

Strong wind from NW by N to NE and rugges & some squalls, Steering SE & latter part of the day Steered SE by S, All sail set, heavy, last boat turned over, I wrote to the Owners

Lat by obs 46, 34 at noon

Monday Oct 15th

Begins with fresh wind from S and hauls to SE, headed off ESE at 6 in the morning, more ship & headed SE by E with a strong wind from E by S, main top gallant sail out, at 9 died away, Calm & took a breeze from SW with fog & squalls, Steered SE by S at 11 AM, Felt good weather, All hands scraping bone, see flocks of birds, gulls, swell from SW

Tuesday Oct 16th

First part fresh breeze from NW and in the morning hauled SEW and Moderate wind, All sail set & steering SE by S, Midday wind hauled SEW and blowed hard in main squalls, Reefed the top sails, Main top sail tie parties, Rained heavily and then left off and all most Calm, Finely looked a squall from West with rain, and the wind blowed on strong from West and a sea, Steering SE by S, Carrying Reefed top sails & Courses, See plenty of black birds, All hands, Scraping bone and most through

Lat by obs at noon 41, 54

Wednesday Oct 17th

Strong gale from West and heavy squalls of wind & rain, Steering SE through the night & SE by S through the day, Carrying Double Reefed top sails, through the night & single Reefed top sails through the day, Some feed on the squalls, See birds, 2 Boats turned over

Lat by obs 38, 25 Long by Ch 161, 30

Thursday Oct 18th

Begins with a fresh breeze from West some squalls, set all sail & the wind hauled to SE, latter part of the day and blowed on strong, shortened sail to Reefed topsails, Weather looking bad and thick, Steering last night SE by E, through the day Steered SE by S, All hands, finished Scraping bone & washed one half of a head, Built a Bone Bin on the quarter Deck, Weather more warm, Steved and a Man washing Cabin & my Room, Reefed to pieces the old main top gallant sail,

Lat by obs 35, 20 Long by Ch 159, 50

Friday Oct 19th

Strong wind from SW and Rain squalls, Steering SE by S, Carrying Reefed topsails & Courses, Swell from SW & the wind has been trying haul there but can't get there, but the clouds come from East, Weather washing bone, Weather warm, Steved & soap washed out the Master's room & the Cabin over her, Took down the stove pipe

Lat by obs 32, 40 Long by Ch 158, 15

Saturday Oct 20th

Fresh breeze from SW by S and good weather, heading from SE to SE by S, Carrying whole topsails, In the fore noon came up with James Allen and spoke her & I went aboard of her and spent the day with Capt Willis, All hands washing bone aboard of us, Half the bone washed clear from number of ships through Capt Willis, All night look out our whale lines to Seaborn salt water
